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# **Defamation Act**

## ORDER FOR MAXIMUM DAMAGES AMOUNT FOR NON-ECONOMIC LOSS IN DEFAMATION PROCEEDINGS

I, JOHAN WESSEL ELFERINK, Attorney-General and Minister for Justice, under section 32(3) of the *Defamation Act*, declare, for the purposes of section 32(1) of that *Act*, that from 1 July 2013 the maximum amount of damages for non-economic loss that may be awarded in defamation proceedings is \$355 500.

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## **Local Government Act**


#### COOMALIE SHIRE WARDS

- I, ALISON ANDERSON, Minister for Local Government, under section 9(2) of the *Local Government Act* and with reference to section 9(1)(f), (g), (h) and (i) of that *Act* and section 42(1) of the *Interpretation Act*.
- (a) abolish the existing wards within the Coomalie Shire; and
- (b) create 3 new wards within the Coomalie Shire; and
- (c) assign the names Adelaide River ward, Batchelor Township ward and Coomalie Rural ward to the new wards; and
- (d) define the boundaries of the new wards as those shown on Compiled Plan CP 5430 in the Schedule; and
- (e) determine the number of members to be elected for each new ward to be 2 members; and
- (f) take the action mentioned in paragraphs (a) to (e) for the purpose of conducting the next general election for the Coomalie Shire and determining the composition of the Coomalie Community Government Council and the Coomalie Shire after that election.
