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Place Names Act NAMING OF PLACE TOWNSEND BRIDGE

- 1 Townsend Bridge is named in commemoration of Henry (Roy) Townsend who personally constructed the bridge to improve wet season access to properties beyond the Finniss River in 1967.
- 2 The bridge has the coordinates Latitude 12° 58' 01.44" South, Longitude 130° 45' 36.37" East, based on the Geocentric Datum of Australia 1994 (GDA94). These references are indicative only and not intended to define the precise extent or location of the bridge.


Names Committee that the place in Girraween, Hundred of Bagot, shown on the diagram in the Schedule, be given the name Aplin Road.

 - (ii) Friday 8 July 2016 (Tennant Creek Regional Show Day); and
 - (iii) Friday 14 July 2017 (Tennant Creek Regional Show Day);
- (d) for the part of the Territory described in Schedule 3:
 - (i) Friday 3 July 2015
 (Alice Springs Regional Show Day); and
 (ii) Friday 1 July 2016
 - (Alice Springs Regional Show Day); and
 - (iii) Friday 7 July 2017(Alice Springs Regional Show Day);
- (e) for the part of the Territory described in Schedule 4:
 - (i) Friday 26 June 2015 (Borroloola Regional Show Day); and
 - (ii) Friday 24 June 2016 (Borroloola Regional Show Day); and
 - (iii) Friday 30 June 2017 (Borroloola Regional Show Day).

SCHEDULE 1

All that parcel of land in the Northern Territory of Australia bounded by lines described as follows: commencing at the intersection of the parallel of south latitude 13 degrees 34 minutes with the sea coast of the Gulf of Carpentaria; thence generally southerly and south-easterly by the said sea coast to intersect the parallel of south latitude 15 degrees 30 minutes; thence west by the said parallel to intersect the meridian of east longitude 135 degrees; thence south by the said meridian to intersect the easterly prolongation of the northern boundary of Northern Territory Portion 2845; thence westerly by the said prolongation, the northern boundary of Northern Territory Portion 2845 and part of the northern boundary of Perpetual Pastoral Lease 1003 (Cattle Creek) to intersect the meridian of east longitude 132 degrees; thence south by the said meridian to intersect the easterly prolongation of the northern boundary of Pastoral Lease 826 (Suplejack); thence westerly by the said prolongation, the northern boundary of Pastoral Lease 826 and its westerly prolongation to intersect the meridian of east longitude 129 degrees being Northern Territory and Western Australia border; thence north by the said meridian to intersect the sea coast of the Timor Sea; thence generally easterly by the said sea coast to intersect the left bank of the Fitzmaurice River; thence generally easterly by the said left bank to intersect the southerly prolongation of the most easterly boundary of Northern Territory Portion 1637; thence northerly, westerly and again northerly by the said prolongation, an eastern, a northern and an eastern boundary of the said Portion to intersect the parallel of south point of commencement, and including all Northern Territory of Australia coastal islands between the parallels of south latitude 13 degrees 34 minutes and 15 degrees 30 minutes, but excluding therefrom the whole of Groote Eylandt.

SCHEDULE 2

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Poisons and Dangerous Drugs Act APPROVAL TO POSSESS AND SUPPLY SCHEDULED SUBSTANCES

I, STEVEN JAYE SKOV, Acting Chief Health Officer:

- (a) under section 29(4A) of the Poisons and Dangerous Drugs Act and with reference to section 43 of the Interpretation Act, revoke all approvals to possess and supply Scheduled substances under section 29(4A) of the Poisons and Dangerous Drugs Act that are in force immediately before the date of this instrument; and
- (b) under section 29(4A) of the Poisons and Dangerous Drugs Act and with reference to section 42 of the Interpretation Act, approve each registered nurse employed and performing duties at premises listed in Appendix A to possess and supply a Schedule 2, 3 or 4 substance, subject to the following conditions:
- (c) a substance listed in Appendix B may only be supplied:
 - (i) by administering it in the manner specified for the substance in Appendix B; and

- (ii) with the personal attendance or advice of a medical practitioner, unless the registered nurse is satisfied on reasonable grounds that the medical condition of the person to whom the substance is to be administered requires its administration without delay; and
- (d) a substance listed in Appendix C may only be supplied by administering it in the manner specified for the substance in Appendix C; and
- (e) a substance listed in Appendix D may only be supplied in accordance with the Scheduled substance treatment protocol for the substance; and
- (f) a substance that it not listed in Appendix B, C or D may only be supplied under the direction or supervision of a medical practitioner.
