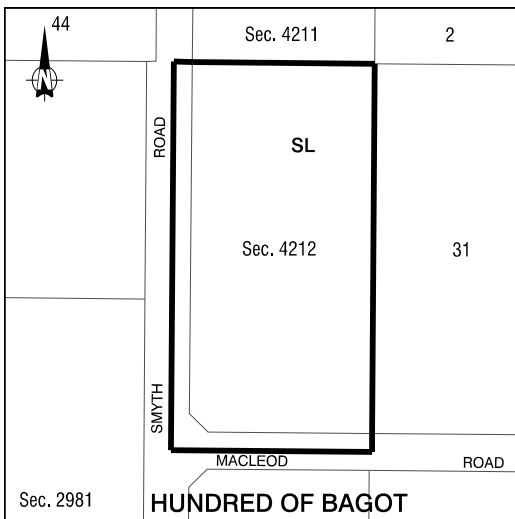
I, MARK GILLEN MELDRUM, delegate of the Minister for Lands, Planning and the Environment give notice under section 17 of the *Planning Act* of the following:

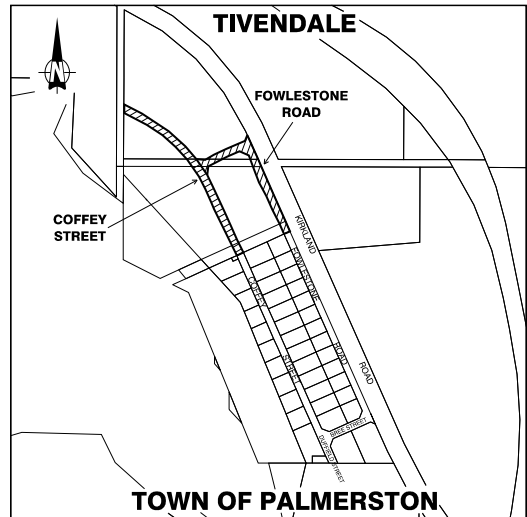

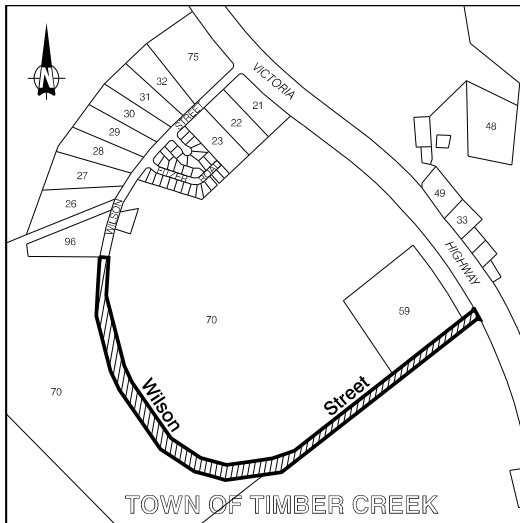

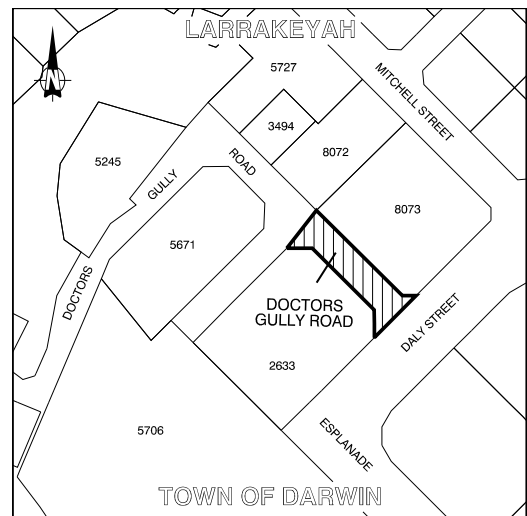
