
Notes

Survey Plan No S2015/198A-G may be inspected at the office of the Surveyor-General, Arnhemica House, Parap, Road, Parap.

Medical Services Act

Revocation and Determination of Charges for Medical Services

Northern Territory of Australia Medical Services Act

Revocation of Declarations and Declaration of Hospitals and Health Centres

I, Natasha Kate Fyles, Minister for Health:

- (a) under section 6(2)(a) of the *Medical Services Act* and with reference to section 43 of the *Interpretation Act*, revoke all declarations of premises, except declarations of premises to be a nursing home, that are in force immediately before the date this declaration is published in the *Gazette*; and
- (b) under section 6(2)(a)(i) of the *Medical Services Act*, declare each premises listed in the Schedule, Part A, to be a hospital; and
- (c) under section 6(2)(a)(iii) of the Act, declare the premises managed by the Department of Health and operating as a health centre at each place listed in the Schedule, Part B, to be an urban health centre; and
- (d) under section 6(2)(a)(iv) of the Act, declare the premises managed by the Department of Health and operating as a health centre at each place listed in the Schedule, Part C, to be a remote health centre.
