Declaration of Compensation Contributions

Lift Incentive Scheme Determination of Persons Eligible and Amount Payable

I, Nicole Susan Manison, Minister for Infrastructure, Planning and Logistics:

- (a) Under regulation 12(5)(a) of the Commercial Passenger (Miscellaneous) Regulations determine that members of the Northern Territory Transport Subsidy Scheme who are reliant on a wheelchair are eligible to participate in the lift incentive scheme; and
- (b) Under regulation 12(5)(b) of the Commercial Passenger (Miscellaneous) Regulations determine that the amount payable for a lift incentive is \$20 for each journey involving a wheelchair.
