Transport of Dangerous Goods by Road and Rail (National Uniform Legislation) Act Appointment of Officers

- I, Stephen Hugh Gelding, the Competent Authority:
 - (a) under section 23(1) of the Transport of Dangerous Goods by Road and Rail (National Uniform Legislation) Act and with reference to section 44 (1) of the Interpretation Act, terminate all appointments of authorised officers in force immediately before the date of this instrument; and
 - (b) under section 23(1) of the *Transport of Dangerous Goods by Road and Rail* (*National Uniform Legislation*) Act, appoint the people named in the Schedule to be authorised officers and exercise the powers under:
 - a) sections 31, 32, 33, 34, 35, 36, 37, 38, 39, 40, 44, 45, 46, 47, 48, 49, 50, 54, 55, 56, 57, 58, 59, 62, 63, 64, 65, 86, 88, 90, 93, 95, 96 and 99 of the *Transport of Dangerous Goods by Road and Rail (National Uniform Legislation) Act*; and
 - b) regulation 232 of the Transport of Dangerous Goods by Road and Rail (National Uniform Legislation) Regulations.

- (i) for clarification; or
- (ii) to correct errors or references; or
- (iii) to reflect changes of address or other circumstances.

Part B

Northern Territory of Australia Territory Parks and Wildlife Conservation Act

Declaration

I, Eva Dina Lawler, Minister for Environment and Natural Resources, under section 45(1) of the *Territory Parks and Wildlife Conservation Act* and with reference to section 45(2) of the Act, declare that it is lawful to kill animals of a species of protected wildlife specified in Schedule 1 or 2 subject to the following conditions:

- (a) the animals may be killed only during the period from 1 October 2018 to 2 January 2019 and between the following times on each day during that period:
 - (i) 6.00 am to 7.00 pm in October;
 - (ii) 5.45 am to 7.15 pm in November;
 - (iii) 5.45 am to 7.30 pm in December;
 - (iv) 6.00 am to 7.30 pm in January;
- (b) the areas within which the animals may be killed are all areas of the Territory except the following:
 - a park, reserve, sanctuary, protected area or wilderness zone under the Act;
 - (ii) any area where, under law in force in the Territory, the discharging of a firearm, as defined in the *Firearms Act*, is prohibited;
- (c) the following type of equipment is to be used to kill the animals specified in Schedule 1:
 - a shotgun of not more than size 10 gauge and not less than size 20 gauge;
 - (ii) shot cartridges:
 - (A) of type non-toxic shot (excluding shot cartridges containing lead, coated lead or zinc shot); and
 - (B) of shot size not more than BBB for all cartridges and not less than No 2 if the cartridges are steel shot and not less than No 4 if the cartridges are other than steel shot;
 - (iii) a bow (excluding a crossbow);

- (d) the following type of equipment is to be used to kill the animals specified in Schedule 2:
 - a shotgun of not more than size 10 gauge and not less than size 20 gauge;
 - (ii) shot cartridges:
 - (A) of type non-toxic shot (excluding shot cartridges containing lead, coated lead or zinc shot); and
 - (B) of shot size not more than BB if the cartridges are steel shot and not more than No 1 if the cartridges are other than steel shot and not less than No 6 for all cartridges;
 - (iii) a bow (excluding a crossbow);
- (e) the maximum number of animals a person may kill in 1 day is:
 - (i) 5 of the animals specified in Schedule 1; and
 - (ii) 10 of the animals specified in Schedule 2;
- (f) the maximum number of dead animals or parts of dead animals a person may have in the person's possession or under the person's control is:
 - (i) away from the person's place of residence 15 of the animals specified in Schedule 1 and 30 of the animals specified in Schedule 2; and
 - (ii) at the person's place of residence unlimited;
- (g) a person wishing to kill the animals cannot do so unless the person has been granted a permit to do so or is a nominee under a permit granted to another person to do so;
- (h) a person:
 - must not sell, barter, dispose of or exchange the dead animals or parts of the dead animals for commercial benefit; and
 - (ii) must not kill the animals except for human consumption; and
 - (iii) must, if requested to do so by a conservation officer, provide information to the officer as to where and when the animal was shot; and

(iv) may use decoys and retriever dogs.
