Northern Territory of Australia Bushfires Management Act

Marrakai Volunteer Bushfire Brigade Change of Name and Area and Appointment of Captain

I, Eva Dina Lawler, Minister for Environment and Natural Resources:

- (a) under section 54(1) of the Bushfires Management Act and with reference to regulation 4(1) of the Bushfires Management (Volunteer Bushfire Brigades) Regulations, alter clause 1 of the constitution of the Beatrice Hill Volunteer Bushfire Brigade by:
 - (i) omitting the words "Beatrice Hill Volunteer Bushfire Brigade"; and
 - (ii) inserting the words "Marrakai Volunteer Bushfire Brigade"; and
- (b) under section 54(1) of the Bushfires Management Act and with reference to section 54(2) of the Act and regulation 4(1) of the Bushfires Management (Volunteer Bushfire Brigades) Regulations, alter clause 2 of the constitution of the Beatrice Hill Volunteer Bushfire Brigade by:
 - (i) omitting all words after "area:"; and
 - (ii) inserting the words and map in the Schedule; and
- (c) under section 54(1) of the *Bushfires Management Act* and with reference to section 54(2) of the Act and section 43 of the *Interpretation Act*, appoint Ralph Arthur Dein to be the captain of the brigade.



Schedule

All that area of land near Beatrice Hill in the Northern Territory of Australia containing an area of 1300 square kilometres more or less and bounded by lines described as follows: Commencing at the most western corner of section 1596 Hundred of Guy; then generally north easterly by the western boundaries of sections 1596 and 1554; continue along prolongation north easterly through Northern Territory Portion 4476 to the northern boundary of Hundred of Guy: then easterly by the said boundary to the left bank of the Adelaide River; then generally north easterly by the said river bank to the westerly prolongation of the northern boundary of Northern Territory Portion 4498; then easterly by the said boundary to its north eastern corner; then southerly by the western boundary of Northern Territory Portion 1170 to its southwestern corner; then westerly along the northern boundary of Northern Territory Portion 4937; then southerly along a western boundary of said portion to the prolongation of the south eastern corner of Northern Territory Portion 2301; then westerly through Northern Territory Portion 6248 and by the southern boundaries of Northern Territory Portions 2301 and 4021 and their westerly prolongation to the left bank of the Adelaide River; then generally north westerly then northerly by the said bank to the southerly prolongation to the centreline of an unnamed road adjoining the eastern boundary of section 241 Hundred of Colton; then northerly by the said prolongation and the centreline of an un-named road adjoining the eastern boundaries of sections 241, 237, 234, 151, 146 and 145 to the westerly prolongation of the centreline of an un-named road adjoining the most southern boundary of section 1455 Hundred of Guy; then easterly by the said centreline to the south easterly prolongation of the centreline of Freds Pass Road; then generally north westerly by the said centreline to the southerly prolongation of the centreline of an un-named road adjoining the western boundary of section 1454; then generally northerly for about 10 kilometres by the said prolongation and centreline and the centreline of an un-named road through Northern Territory Portion 4477 (Koolpinyah) to intersect the centreline of Goode Road adjoining a northern boundary of the said portion; then easterly by the said centreline to intersect the centreline of the Humpty Doo Access road; then north westerly along said centreline to the prolongation of the north western

corner of section 1584; then north easterly along northern boundary of said section and north western boundary of section 1712 to the north western corner of section 1550; then northerly across the Arnhem Highway to the Point of commencement, as shown for information purposes only delineated in black on the following map:




