## Northern Territory of Australia <br> Motor Vehicles Act 1949 <br> Declaration of Compensation Contributions

I, Nicole Susan Manison, Treasurer, under section 47(1) of the Motor Vehicles Act 1949, declare that for the class of vehicle or plate described in the Schedule, the amount specified opposite is the amount of compensation contributions payable on and from 1 July 2019 for the following:
(a) the grant or renewal of the registration of a motor vehicle;
(b) the grant or renewal of a pastoral vehicle permit;
(c) the grant of an exemption from registration of a visiting motor vehicle under section 8A of the Act;
(d) the grant of a licence under section 137 of the Act;
(e) the issuing of a trader's plate;
(f) an application for registration or re-registration under the Interstate Road Transport Act 1985 (Cth) of a motor vehicle or trailer.
