# Education Act 2015 Education Regulations 2015

#### **Determination of Fees Payable by International Students**

- I, Selena Jane Malijarri Uibo, Minister for Education, under regulation 14(1) of the *Education Regulations 2015* and with reference to section 67(1) of the *Education Act 2015*, determine that the fees payable by international students enrolled in Government schools are:
- (a) for education services provided to an international student by a Government school:
  - (i) for a year at a year level specified in the Schedule the fee specified opposite in the Schedule for the year level during the specified calendar year; or
  - (ii) if the student is enrolled at a Government school for less than a year the fee referred to in subparagraph (i) adjusted on a pro-rata basis; and
- (b) for the provision to an international student of facilities or arrangements for an international student's accommodation a fee of \$200 each time the student is placed in accommodation.

#### Petroleum Act 1984

Release of Information under Section 61(8)

- I, Christine Lara Cakebread, the Delegate of the Minister for Primary Industries and Resources, in pursuance of section 61(8) of the Petroleum Act 1984 -
- (a) notify that I propose to make the information specified in the Schedule available or publicly known;
- (b) invite interested persons to give to me, within 45 days after the publication of this notice, a notice objecting to the whole or any part of the information being made available or publicly known; and
- (c) notify that if a person does not make an objection in accordance with this invitation, the person will be taken to have consented to the information being made available or publicly known.

#### Note

- 1. A notice objecting to information being made available or publicly known shall set out the person's reasons for making the objection.
- 2. A person may not object to information being made available or publicly known under this -
  - (a) a trade secret; or
  - (b) any other information the disclosure of which would, or could reasonably be expected to, adversely affect the person in respect of the lawful business, commercial or financial affairs of the person.
