Declaration of Maximum Amount of Damages for Non-Pecuniary Loss

- I, Natasha Kate Fyles, Attorney-General and Minister for Justice, under section 28(1) of the *Personal Injuries (Liabilities and Damages) Act 2003*:
- (a) declare that the maximum amount of damages a court may award for non-pecuniary loss, applicable for section 27(1) of the Act, is \$662 000; and
- (b) state that this declaration takes effect on 1 October 2019.

Proclamation

Northern Territory of Australia Vicki Susan O'Halloran Administrator By Her Honour the Administrator of the Northern Territory of Australia

I, Vicki Susan O'Halloran, Administrator of the Northern Territory of Australia, acting with the advice of the Executive Council, under section 76(1)(c) of the *Crown Lands Act 1992*, reserve the unalienated Crown land described in the Schedule, to be known as Reserve No. 1833, for the protection and conservation of wildlife.

All that area of land and sea in Shoal Bay in the Darwin Region in the Northern Territory of Australia containing an area of 50 hectares or thereabouts and designated Northern Territory Portion 7495(A) and contained within a rectangle commencing at a point bearing 357 degrees 31 minutes and 2324.8 metres from the most western north-western corner of Section 3123, Hundred of Bagot, and thence by lines bearing 270 degrees for 550 metres, 360 degrees for 909.1 metres, 90 degrees for 550 metres and 180 degrees for 909.1 metres to the point of commencement.
