- (b) for section 85A(2) of the Act, specify that the requirements of the program are as set out in the Schedule.

Program Requirements Marraka Mbarintja Men's Behaviour Change Program

1 The defendant must, during a 5 month period, attend 16 group sessions or, if negotiated with the program facilitator, equivalent individual sessions.

- The defendant must not miss 2 consecutive sessions without a reasonable excuse; and
- In addition to the sessions mentioned in clause 1, the defendant must attend individual meetings with the program facilitator on request by the program facilitator.
- The defendant must accept that independent support will be offered to the protected person.
- 5 The defendant must:
 - (a) actively participate in the program; and
 - (b) behave respectfully; and
 - (c) not engage in conduct that is threatening or intimidating to any person.
- The defendant must sign a participation agreement and abide by the rules and arrangements set out in the agreement.
