#### FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, Graham Tapley or his registered master, (hereinafter referred to as the 'fisher'), P.O. Box 1635, Port Lincoln, S.A. 5606 is exempt from the provisions of licence condition number 43 subject to the conditions set out in the schedule.

#### SCHEDULE

- 1. The fisher shall use no more than 60 pots in addition to the number of rock lobster pots currently endorsed in fishery licence N088, the maximum being 120 rock lobster pots in total until 25 January 1999.
- 2. No fee shall be payable by the fisher in respect to the rock lobster pots being used in addition to the number of rock lobster pots currently endorsed on the fishery licence.
- 3. The fisher shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982 or any regulation made under that Act or any condition of his/her licence, except where specifically exempted by this notice.
- 4. While engaged in the permitted activity the fisher shall have in their possession a copy of this notice. Such notice must be produced to a PIRSA Fisheries and Aquaculture Compliance Officer if such an officer requests that it be produced.
