FISHERIES ACT 1982

Delegation under Section 23

PURSUANT to section 23 of the Fisheries Act 1982, I, Gary Raymond Morgan, Director of Fisheries, hereby delegate to Richard Stevens, Deputy Chief Executive of the Department of Primary Industries and Resources, my powers under sections 49 and 50 of the Fisheries Act 1982, to issue permits for the introduction, sale or purchase of exotic fish in the State and the release of exotic or farm fish into State waters.

FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that, pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, Tracy Warland (hereinafter referred to as the 'permit holder'), P.O. Box 2236, Port Lincoln, S.A. 5606 is exempt from the Fisheries Act 1982, in that she shall not be guilty of an offence when engaging in the activities specified in Schedule 1 (hereinafter referred to as the 'permitted activity') subject to the conditions specified in Schedule 2 from the waters described in Schedule 3 from the date of gazettal of this notice until 30 June 2000

SCHEDULE 1

The collection of marine amphipods from beach-cast seagrass wrack.

SCHEDULE 2

- 1. All specimens taken shall be for the supplementing of diet for seahorse captive breeding program and may not be sold.
- 2. Before collecting any specimens pursuant to this notice, the permit holder must notify PIRSA Fisheries and Aquaculture on (1800 065 522) with details of the proposed location and dates on which collections are to be made.
- 3. The permit holder shall only conduct the activity from beaches to the high water mark within the permitted area.
- 4. Whilst engaged in the permitted activity the permit holder must be in possession of a copy of this notice. Such notice must be produced to a PIRSA Fisheries and Aquaculture Compliance Officer if such an officer requests that it be produced.
- 5. The permit holder shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982, or any regulations made under that Act, except where specifically permitted by this notice.
