FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, C. McCathie (M403), P.O. Box 1654, Port Lincoln, S.A. 5606 (hereinafter referred to as the 'fisher'), is exempt from the Fisheries Act 1982, but only insofar as the fisher may take sand crabs (*Ovalipes australiensis*) below the legal minimum length and females with external eggs (hereinafter referred to as the 'permitted activity') subject to the conditions specified in Schedule 1 from 6 December 1999 until 10 December 1999.

SCHEDULE 1

- 1. The fisher must contact the PIRSA Fisheries and Aquaculture Compliance Unit on 1800 065 522 prior to conducting the permitted activity.
- 2. The fisher may take no more than 20 sand crabs (Ovalipes australiensis) below the legal minimum length.
- 3. The fisher may take no more than 20 female sand crabs ($Ovalipes\ australiensis$) with external eggs.
- 4. All sand crabs (*Ovalipes australiensis*) taken pursuant to this notice must be delivered to the South Australian Research and Development Institute (SARDI).
- 5. Whilst engaged in the permitted activity the fisher must be in possession of a copy of this notice. Such notice must be produced to a PIRSA Fisheries and Aquaculture Compliance Officer if such an offer requests that it be produced.
- 6. The fisher shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982, or any regulations made under that Act, except where specifically exempted by this notice.
