FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, R. V. Baudinette or persons acting as his agents (hereinafter referred to as the 'permit holders'), Faculty of Science, The University of Adelaide, Adelaide, S.A. 5000 are exempt from the provisions of the Fisheries Act 1982, in that the permit holders shall not be guilty of an offence when importing and possessing up to 20 lungfish (Neoceratodus fosteri) (hereinafter referred to as the 'permitted activity') subject to the conditions specified in Schedule 1, from the date of gazettal of this notice.

SCHEDULE 1

- 1. The permit holders must maintain all fish held pursuant to this notice on the premises of the University of Adelaide.
- 2. The permit holders shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982 or any regulations made under that Act, except where specifically exempted by this notice.
- 3. While engaging in the permitted activity, the permit holders must be in possession of a copy of this notice. Such notice must be produced to a PIRSA Fisheries and Aquaculture Compliance Officer if such an officer requests that it be produced.
