FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, Robert W. Baker (hereinafter referred to as the 'permit holder') P.O. Box 267, Port Lincoln, S.A. 5606 is exempt from clause 76 of Schedule 1 of the Fisheries (General) Regulations 1984, subject to the conditions specified in Schedule 1, in that the permit holder shall not be guilty of an offence when taking southern rock lobster (*Jasus edwardsii*) for the purpose of trade or business during the closed season (hereinafter referred to as the 'permitted activity').

SCHEDULE 1

- $1.\ This$ permit is valid from $1800\ hours$ on $31\ May\ 1999$ until $1800\ hours$ on $3\ June\ 1999.$
- 2. All fishing operations conducted pursuant to this notice must be conducted pursuant to northern zone rock lobster licence N003.
- 3. The permit holder must notify the PIRSA Fisheries and Aquaculture Compliance Unit on 1800 065 522 immediately upon landing southern rock lobster (*Jasus edwardsii*) taken pursuant to this notice and provide the name of the registered processor to whom the southern rock lobster (*Jasus edwardsii*) will be delivered and the estimated weight of the catch.
- 4. Whilst engaged in the permitted activity the permit holder must have in his possession a copy of this notice and produce a copy of the notice if required by a PIRSA Fisheries and Aquaculture Compliance Officer.
- 5. The permit holder shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982, or any regulations made under the Act, except where specifically exempted by this notice.
