EMERGENCY SERVICES FUNDING ACT 1998 SECTION 24: DECLARATION OF THE AMOUNT OF THE LEVY UNDER DIVISION 2 OF PART 3

Notice by the Governor

PURSUANT to section 24 of the *Emergency Services Funding Act 1998*, on the recommendation of the Minister for Police, Correctional Services and Emergency Services (being the delegate Minister of the Minister for Justice under section 9A of the *Administrative Arrangements Act 1994*) and with the advice and consent of the Executive Council, I, for the purposes of declaring the amount of the levy under Division 2 of Part 3 of the *Emergency Services Funding Act 1998*:

- (a) divide motor vehicles into classes referred to in the schedule (being the same classes as the Premium Class Code published by the Motor Accident Commission) and specify the amount of the levy in respect of each class in accordance with the schedule; and
- (b) specify \$12 as the amount of the levy in respect of vessels; and
- (c) specify that this notice will apply in relation to the following financial years:
 - in respect of all classes of motor vehicles other than vehicles within classes 18 and 68, and in respect of all vessels—the 1999-2000 and 2000-2001 financial years;
 - (ii) in respect of motor vehicles within classes 18 and 68—the 1999-2000, 2000-2001, 2001-2002 and 2002-2003 financial years.

EMERGENCY SERVICES FUNDING ACT 1998 SECTION 25: EXEMPTIONS BY THE MINISTER

Notice by the Minister

PURSUANT to section 25 of the *Emergency Services Funding Act 1998*, I, the Minister for Police, Correctional Services and Emergency Services, being the delegate Minister of the Minister for Justice under section 9A of the *Administrative Arrangements Act 1994*, exempt the following classes of motor vehicles and vessels from the imposition of a levy under Division 2 of Part 3 of the *Emergency Services Funding Act 1998*:

- (a) motor vehicles within classes 17, 18, 67 and 68 under the Premium Class Code published by the Motor Accident Commission;
- (b) trailers designed for the carriage of vessels;
- (c) vessels that are subject to more than one registration under the Harbors and Navigation Act 1993, but only insofar as is necessary to ensure that any such vessel is not subject to more than one levy in any financial year;
- (d) vessels used as small yacht tenders that are exempt from registration charges under the Harbors and Navigation Act 1993
