## FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that, pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, those persons specified in Schedule 1, (hereinafter referred to as the 'fisher') are exempt from section 44 (1) of the Fisheries Act 1982, insofar as the fisher may take fish for trade or business whilst not being the holder of a licence pursuant to regulations made under the Fisheries Act 1982 (hereinafter referred to as the 'permitted activity') subject to the conditions outlined in Schedule 2 during the period 1 August 1999 to 31 August 1999 or until this notice is revoked, whichever being the earlier.

SCHEDULE 1

Those persons who held a licence pursuant to the Scheme of Management (River Fishery) Regulations 1991 during the licensing year 1998-99 and who have paid all fees due for the 1998-99 year.

## SCHEDULE 2

1. All fishing activity conducted pursuant to this notice must be conducted in accordance with the conditions and endorsements applicable to the last licence held by the fisher for the 1998-99 licensing year; and

2. The fisher shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982 or any regulations made under that Act, except where specifically exempted by this notice.
