FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that, pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, those persons specified in Schedule 1 (hereinafter referred to as the 'fish farmers') are exempt from sections 44 (1), 48G, 50 (2) and 53 of the Fisheries Act 1982 insofar as the fish farmers may take farmed fish for trade or business, disturb the seabed for the purpose of installing the approved structures, release the permitted species for the purpose of farming and occupy the site whilst not being the holder of a fish farming licence, pursuant to section 53 of the Fisheries Act 1982 issued subject to the conditions outlined in Schedule 2 during the period 1 July 1999 to 31 July 1999 or until this notice is revoked, whichever being the earlier.

SCHEDULE 1

1. Those fish farmers who held a licence pursuant to section 53 of the Fisheries Act 1982 on 30 June 1999 and who have paid all fees due for the 1998-99 licensing year.

SCHEDULE 2

1. All activities conducted pursuant to this notice must be conducted in accordance with the terms and conditions applicable to the fish farming licence held on 30 June 1999.

2. The fish farmers must not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982 or any regulations made under that Act, except where specifically exempted by this notice.
