### FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, all persons competing in the 'Fantastic Fisherama' fishing competition (hereinafter referred to as the 'exemption holder') and registered by Fantastic Fisherama Inc., 67 Ridge Road, Murray Bridge, S.A. 5253, are exempt from the Fisheries Act 1982, but only insofar as the exemption holder shall not be guilty of an offence when using aquacultured yabbies (*Cherax destructor*) as bait (hereinafter referred to as the 'exempted activity'), subject to the conditions set out in the schedule from 21 October 2000 until 22 October 2000 inclusive.

#### SCHEDULE

1. All yabbies (*Cherax destructor*) used pursuant to this notice may be used for bait only.

2. All yabbies (*Cherax destructor*) used pursuant to this notice must be supplied by a registered aquaculturalists approved by the General Manager Aquaculture (hereinafter referred to as the 'approved supplier').

3. All yabbies (*Cherax destructor*) not used for bait must be either destroyed or returned to the approved supplier.

4. The exemption holder shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982, or any regulations made under that Act, except where specifically exempted by this notice.
