FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, George Manias (hereinafter referred to as the 'exemption holder'), P.O. Box 97, Streaky Bay, S.A. 5680, holder of Marine Scalefish Fishery Licence No. M288, is exempt from the provision of Schedule 1, Clause 61 of the Fisheries (General) Regulations 2000 but only insofar as the exemption holder shall not be guilty of an offence when taking up to 150 razor fish (*Pinna bicolor*) in any one day, subject to the conditions specified in Schedule 1, from South Australian coastal marine waters from the date of gazettal of this notice until 30 June 2001.

SCHEDULE 1

- $1. \ All \ razor \ fish \ (Pinna \ bicolor)$ taken pursuant to this notice shall be used for bait only.
- 2. The total number of razor fish (*Pinna bicolor*) taken in any one day, shall be no greater than one hundred and fifty.
- 3. The exemption holder must include all razor fish $Pinna\ bicolor$) taken under this permit on his monthly catch and effort summary provided to the South Australian Research and Development Institute (SARDI).
- 4. Whilst engaged in the collection activity the exemption holder must have in or about his possession the copy of this notice and produce that notice to a PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Officer forthwith, if and when an officer requests the exemption holder to produce it.
- 5. The exemption holder shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982, or any regulations made under the Act, except where specifically exempted by this notice. Dated 3 November 2000.
