#### FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 43

TAKE notice that it is hereby declared that it shall be unlawful for any person to engage in the class of fishing activity specified in Schedule 1 during the periods specified in Schedule 2.

The act of taking or the act preparatory to or involved in the taking of western king prawn (*Penaeus latisulcatus*) in waters of Spencer Gulf north of a line commencing at position latitude  $33^{\circ}29.40'$ S, longitude  $137^{\circ}18.00'$ E, then to position latitude  $33^{\circ}29.40'$ S, longitude  $137^{\circ}30.40'$ E, then to position latitude  $33^{\circ}23.60'$ S, longitude  $137^{\circ}33.20'$ E, then to position latitude  $33^{\circ}23.60'$ S, longitude  $137^{\circ}35.70'$ E, then to position latitude  $33^{\circ}14.90'$ S, longitude  $137^{\circ}37.40'$ E, then to position latitude  $33^{\circ}14.90'$ S, longitude  $137^{\circ}50.00'$ E.
