FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, M. J. Wilson or their registered master (hereinafter referred to as the 'fisher') of Kongarong, S.A. 5291, is exempt from the provisions of licence condition No. 41 subject to the conditions set out in the schedule.

THE SCHEDULE

- 1. The fisher shall use no more than 42 pots in addition to the number of rock lobster pots currently endorsed on fishery licence S139, the maximum being 92 rock lobster pots in total until 7 March 2000.
- 2. No fee shall be payable by the fisher in respect to the rock lobster pots being used in addition to the number of rock lobster pots currently endorsed on the fishery licence.
- 3. Rock loster taken from the additional 42 pots must be recorded on a SZRL1 form for fishery licence S127 (M. Wilson) and not included on the SZRL1 form for fishery licence S139.
- 4. The fisher shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982, or any Regulation made under that Act or any condition of the licence, except where specifically exempted by this notice.
- 5. While engaged in the permitted activity the fisher shall have in their possession a copy of this notice. Such notice must be produced to a Fisheries Compliance Officer if such an officer requests that it be produced.
