FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, the class of persons specified in Schedule 1 and Ian Hills, P.O. Box 151, Warooka, S.A. 5577 (hereinafter referred to as the 'charter boat operator') is exempt from the provisions of Clause 71AA and Clause 70 (b) of Schedule 1 of the Fisheries (General) Regulations 1984, and section 41 of the Fisheries Act 1982, insofar as the charter boat operator may exceed the boat limits as specified in Schedule 2, subject to the conditions specified in Schedule 3.

SCHEDULE 1

Any person or persons who charter the boat *Jeremiah* (hereinafter referred to as the 'permitted boat') from the charter boat operator in South Australia, for the purpose of recreational fishing for scalefish.

SCHEDULE 2

The charter boat operator may engage in the taking of no more than one half of the daily bag limit (for those species of scalefish subject to such a limit as specified in the Fisheries (General) Regulations 1984, per paying passenger in any one day where the number of paying passengers exceeds five.

SCHEDULE 3

- 1. This exemption is valid from the date of gazettal of this notice until 30 June 2001.
- 2. The charter boat operator shall not use any other boats for the purpose of engaging in the permitted activity except the
- 3. The charter boat operator shall not sell any fish taken pursuant to this notice.
- 4. The charter boat operator shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982, or any regulations made under that Act except where specifically exempted by this notice.

5. While engaged in the permitted activity the charter boat operator shall have in their possession a copy of this notice. Such notice must be produced to a PIRSA Fisheries and Aquaculture Compliance Officer if such an officer requests that it be so produced.

FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, Todreel Pty Ltd or their agent, 1 Port Road, Hindmarsh, S.A. 5007 (hereinafter referred to as the 'exemption holder') is exempt from the notice made under section 43 of the Fisheries Act 1982, prohibiting the taking of western king prawns (*Penaeus latisulcatus*) in the waters of Gulf St Vincent, in that they shall not be guilty of an offence when using a prawn trawl net for the purpose of trade or business (hereinafter referred to as the 'permitted activity') subject to the conditions contained in Schedule 1 from 26 April 2000 to 27 April 2000 (inclusive).

SCHEDULE 1

- 1. The exemption holder may only engage in the permitted activity using the vessel *Jillian Sandra* endorsed on commercial fishery licence No. V06.
- 2. The exemption holder may only take up to a maximum of 200 kg of prawns pursuant to this exemption.
- 3. The exemption holder must notify a PIRSA Fisheries and Aquaculture Compliance Officer on 1800 065 522, two hours prior to commencing the permitted activity and prior to landing the prawns.
- 4. The exemption holder shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982, except where specifically exempted by this notice.

- 5. Whilst engaged in the permitted activity the exemption holder must be in possession of a copy of this notice. Such notice must be produced to a PIRSA Fisheries and Aquaculture Compliance Officer if such an officer requests that it be produced.
- 6. PIRSA Fisheries retains the right for a departmental officer to accompany the exemption holder at any time whilst conducting the permitted activity.
