FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, Todreel Pty Ltd, 1 Port Road, Hindmarsh, S.A. 5007 (hereinafter referred to as the 'exemption holder') is exempt from the notice No. V0019/00 made under section 43 of the Fisheries Act 1982, dated 26 April 2000, prohibiting the taking of western king prawns (*Penaeus latisulcatus*) in the waters of Gulf St Vincent, in that they shall not be guilty of an offence when using a prawn trawl net for the purpose of trade or business (hereinafter referred to as the 'permitted activity') subject to the conditions contained in Schedule 1.

SCHEDULE 1

1. The exemption holder may only engage in the permitted activity using the vessel *Jillian Sandra* endorsed on commercial fishery licence No. V06.

2. The exemption holder may only take up to a maximum of 200 kg of prawns pursuant to this exemption.

3. The exemption holder may only engage in the permitted activity for 1 night between 23 May 2000 to 25 May 2000 (inclusive).

4. The exemption holder must notify the PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Unit on 1800 065 522, at least 2 hours prior to commencing the permitted activity.

5. The exemption holder must notify the PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Unit on 1800 065 522, at least 1 hour prior to landing any western king prawns (*Penaeus latisulcatus*) taken pursuant to this notice.

6. The exemption holder shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982, except where specifically exempted by this notice.

7. Whilst engaged in the permitted activity the exemption holder must be in possession of a copy of this notice. Such notice must be produced to a PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Officer if such an officer requests that it be produced.

8. PIRSA Fisheries retains the right for a departmental officer to accompany the exemption holder at any time whilst conducting the permitted activity.
