FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, the class of persons specified in Schedule 1 and Brad March Charter Services, P.O. Box 151, Henley Beach, S.A. 5022 (hereinafter referred to as the 'exemption holder') are exempt from the provisions of Clause 71AA and Clause $70\,(b)$ of Schedule 1 of the Fisheries (General) Regulations 1984, and section 41 of the Fisheries Act 1982, insofar as the exemption holder may exceed the boat limits as specified in Schedule 2 (hereinafter referred to as the 'permitted activity'), subject to the conditions specified in schedule 3.

SCHEDULE 1

Any person or persons who charter the boat *Columbia* (hereinafter referred to as the 'permitted boat') from the exemption holder in South Australia.

SCHEDULE 2

- 2. The exemption holder may engage in the taking of no more than one abalone (*Haliotis spp.*) per paying passenger in any one day where the number of paying passengers exceeds ten.
- 3. The exemption holder may engage in the taking of no more than twenty blue swimmer crab (*Portunus pelagicus*) per paying passenger in any one day where the number of paying passengers exceeds six.
- 4. The exemption holder may engage in the taking of no more than one half of the daily bag limit (for those species of scalefish subject to such a limit as specified in the Fisheries (General) Regulations 1984 per paying passenger in any one day where the number of paying passengers exceeds five.

SCHEDULE 3

- 1. This exemption is valid from the date of gazettal of this notice until 30 June 2001.
- 2. The exemption holder shall not use any other boat other than the permitted boat for the purpose of engaging in the permitted activity.
- 3. The exemption holder shall not sell any fish taken pursuant to this notice.
