FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, Museum Victoria or persons acting as their agents (hereinafter referred to as the 'exemption holder'), G.P.O. Box 666E, Melbourne, Vic. 3001, are exempt from section 41 of the Fisheries Act 1982, but only insofar as the exemption holder shall not be guilty of an offence when engaging in the collection of aquatic organisms from the waters and catchments of the Warburton River (hereinafter referred to as the 'permitted activity'), using the gear specified in Schedule 1, subject to the conditions set out in Schedule 2 from the date of gazettal of this notice until 4 August 2000.

SCHEDULE 1

- 1 seine net
- 5 fish traps
- 5 fyke nets
- 1 gill net

SCHEDULE 2

1. All fish taken pursuant to this notice are for museum collection purposes only and may not be sold.

2. The exemption holder may not take more than 10 of any one species pursuant to this notice.

3. The permitted activity undertaken pursuant to this notice must be conducted by John McGuckin.

4. Before collecting any specimens pursuant to this exemption, the exemption holder must advise the PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Unit on 1800 065 522 with details of the proposed locations and the dates on which the collections are to be made.

5. Within 14 days of the collection of organisms pursuant to this exemption, the exemption holder must provide a report in writing to the Director of Fisheries, (Attention: Roger Hill, G.P.O. Box 1625, Adelaide, S.A. 5001), giving the date and time of collection; the description of all species collected; the number of each species collected; and the number of mortalities resulting from collecting.

6. The exemption holder shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982 or any regulations made under that Act, except where specifically exempted by this notice.

7. Whilst engaged in the permitted activity, the exemption holder must have in their possession of a copy of this notice and produce a copy of the notice if required by a PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Officer.
