FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, Daniel Brock, (hereinafter referred to as the 'exemption holder') of the University of Adelaide, Roseworthy Campus, Roseworthy, S.A. 5371 is exempt from section 41 of the Fisheries Act 1982 but only insofar as the exemption holder shall not be guilty of an offence when using up to a maximum of 10 rock lobster pots and taking and possessing no more than 40 southern rock lobster (*Jasus edwardsii*), below the legal minimum length, (hereinafter referred to as the 'permitted activity') subject to the conditions specified in Schedule 1, from the waters of the northern zone rock lobster fishery from the date of this notice including the closed season of the Northern Zone rock lobster season until 31 December 2000.

SCHEDULE 1

1. Any southern rock lobster (*Jasus edwardsii*) taken pursuant to this notice are for research purposes only and must not be sold.
2. PIRSA Fisheries retains the right for a departmental officer to observe the permitted activity at any time.
3. All southern rock lobster (*Jasus edwardsii*) taken pursuant to this notice must be transported immediately to the South Australian Research and Development Institute's Aquatic Science Centre and remain at this location.
4. The exemption holder shall notify the PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Unit on 1800 065 522 at least twenty-four hours prior to conducting the permitted activity with the following information:

- details of the boat (if any) that will be used to engage in the permitted activity;
 - the intended area of conducting the permitted activity; and
 - if conducting the permitted activity from a boat, the intended place and time of launching and retrieval of the nominated boat for that day.
5. Whilst engaged in the permitted activity the exemption holder must have in his possession a copy of this notice and produce a copy of the notice if required by a PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Officer.
 6. The exemption holder shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982, or any regulations made under the Act, except where specifically exempted by this notice.
