#### FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that, subject to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, those holders of a licence issued pursuant to the Scheme of Management (Abalone Fisheries) Regulations 1991, (hereinafter referred to as the 'exemption holder'), are exempted from the provisions of regulations 10 (2) (b) of the Scheme of Management (Abalone Fisheries) Regulations 1991, in that the exemption holder shall be permitted to register a second boat, subject to the conditions specified in Schedule 1, from the date of gazettal of this notice until 30 June 2001 unless revoked earlier.

#### SCHEDULE 1

- 1. The exemption holder may only register an additional boat where no more than one other boat is registered by endorsement of the applicant's licence in respect of the fishery.
- 2. The exemption holder shall not use both boats, or cause, suffer or permit both boats to be used, within any one day in an act of taking or the act preparatory to or involved in the taking of abalone (Haliotis Spp.) pursuant to a licence issued subject to the Scheme of Management (Abalone Fisheries) Regulations 1991.
- 3. The exemption holder shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982, or any other regulations made under that Act except where specifically exempted by this notice.
