FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, Tracy Venus (hereinafter referred to as the 'exemption holder') of the Australian Water Quality Centre, PMB 3, Salisbury, S.A. 5108, is exempt from the provisions of clause 63D of Schedule 1 of the Fisheries (General) Regulations 1984 but only insofar as the exemption holder may engage in the collection of *Hormosira banskii* from South Australian coastal waters (including intertidal rocky reefs) adjacent to the Adelaide metropolitan area (hereinafter referred to as the 'exempted activity'), subject to the conditions set out in Schedule 1 from the date of the gazettal of this notice until 31 October 2001.

SCHEDULE 1

1. All specimens collected by the exemption holder pursuant to this notice are for scientific and research purposes and must not be sold.

2. Before collecting any specimens pursuant to this notice, the exemption holder must notify PIRSA Fisheries on 1800 065 522 with details of the proposed locations and the dates on which the collections are to be made.

3. While engaging in the exempted activity, the exemption holder must be in possession of a copy of this notice. Such notice must be produced to a PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Officer if such an officer requests that it be produced.

4. The exemption holder shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982 or any regulations made under that Act, except where specifically exempted by this notice.

FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that subject to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, those holders of a licence issued pursuant to the Scheme of Management (Abalone Fisheries) Regulations 1991 (hereinafter referred to as the 'exemption holders') are exempted from the provisions of Regulations 19(1) of the Fisheries (General) Regulations 1984 and from Regulation 10(1) and Regulation 12(2) of the Scheme of Management (Abalone Fisheries) Regulations 1991 in that the exemption holders shall not be guilty of an offence when using a boat registered by endorsement on a fishery licence pursuant to Division 1, Part 4 of the Fisheries Act 1982 for recreational fishing (hereinafter referred to as the 'exempted activity'), subject to the conditions specified in Schedule 1, from the date of gazettal of this notice until 30 June 2001.

SCHEDULE 1

1. The exemption holders must notify the PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Unit via Link Communications on 1800 244 317 prior to engaging in the exempted activity with the following information:

- the commercial boat registration number and the fishery licence number to which the call applies;
- the name of the person making the call (must be licence holder or a registered master) and the abalone fishery licence number;
- the recreational registration numbers which will be placed on the boat;
- · the time and date recreation use will commence; and
- · the time and date recreation use will cease.

2. The exemption holders shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982, or any other regulations made under that Act except where specifically exempted by this notice.

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, Cheries Heyes or persons acting as her agents (hereinafter referred to as the 'exemption holder') from the School of Biological Sciences, Flinders University of South Australia, G.P.O. Box 2100, Adelaide, S.A. 5001 is exempt from the provisions of section 48G of the Fisheries Act 1982 but only insofar as to engage in the collection of leaves and pneumataphores from mangroves (*Avicennia marina*) in the Barker Inlet—St Kilda Aquatic Reserve (hereinafter referred to as the 'exempted activity'), subject to the conditions set out in Schedule 1 from the date of gazettal of this notice until 28 February 2001.

SCHEDULE 1

1. No more than 30 leaves and 30 pneumataphores from mangroves (*Avicennia marina*) are to be collected during the term of this notice.

2. The specimens collected by the permit holder are for scientific and research purposes only and may not be sold.

3. Collections undertaken in the Barker Inlet—St Kilda Aquatic Reserve must be undertaken with due consideration of other members of the public already in the area.

4. Before collecting any specimens pursuant to this notice, the exemption holder must advise a PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Officer on 1800 065 522 with details of the proposed locations and the dates on which the collections are to be made.

5. While engaging in the exempted activity, the exemption holder must be in possession of a copy of this notice. Such notice must be produced to a PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Officer if such an officer requests that it be produced.

6. The exemption holder shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982 or any regulations made under that Act, except where specifically exempted by this notice.
