FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE note that the notice made under section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, and published in the *South Australian Government Gazette* on page number 2326, dated 29 September 2000, referring to Dr Wolfgang Zeidler and the collection of marine organisms, is hereby revoked.

FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, Ronald C. Bott (hereinafter referred to as the 'exemption holder'), Box 430, Kingscote, S.A. 5223, is exempt from the provisions of section 41 of the Fisheries Act 1982, but only insofar as the exemption holder shall not be guilty of an offence when taking up to a maximum of 4 black bream (*Acanthopagrus butcheri*) below the legal minimum length (hereinafter referred to as the 'exempted activity') from the waters of the Cygnet and Chapman rivers, subject to the conditions specified in Schedule 1, from the date of gazettal of this notice until 30 January 2001.

SCHEDULE 1

- 1. All fish taken pursuant to this notice are for display purposes only, and must be provided to the Kangaroo Island Marine Centre, and must not be sold or released.
- 2. The exemption holder must, within 14 days of collection of fish pursuant to this notice, provide a written report to PIRSA Fisheries (PIRSA Fisheries, Roger Hill, G.P.O. Box 1625, Adelaide, S.A. 5001) with details of the number of fish captured, the number of fish released into the display site and the number of mortalities.
- 3. The exemption holder must notify the PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Unit on 1800 065 522 at least four hours prior to conducting the permitted activity and provide the following information:

- the intended launch and retrieval time and location;
- · the intended fishing area; and
- details of the boat to be used.
- 4. While engaged in the exempted activity, the exemption holder shall carry or have about or near his person, a copy of this notice. Such notice must be produced to a PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Officer upon request.
- 5. The exemption holder shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982, or any regulation made under that Act, except where specifically exempted by this notice.

FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, Dr Wolfgang Zeidler or persons acting as his agents (hereinafter referred to as the 'exemption holder') from the South Australian Museum, North Terrace, Adelaide, S.A. 5000 is exempt from the provisions of the Fisheries Act (Aquatic Reserves) Regulations 1989 and clause 65 of Schedule 1 of the Fisheries (General) Regulations 1984, but only insofar as the exemption holder may collect marine organisms from South Australian coastal waters including intertidal 'rocky' reefs using the gear specified in Schedule 1 (hereinafter referred to as the 'exempted activity') or by using chemical anaesthetics, subject to the conditions set out in Schedule 2 from the date of gazettal of this notice until 30 June 2001.

1 x dredge 1 x handspear per person

1 x speargun per person

SCHEDULE 2

- 1. The specimens collected by the exemption holder are for scientific purposes only and may not be sold.
- 2. At least 24 hours prior to collecting any specimens pursuant to this notice, the permit holder must advise PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Unit on 1800 065 522 with details of the proposed locations and the dates on which the collections are to be made.
- 3. While engaging in the exempted activity, the exemption holder must be in possession of a copy of this notice. Such notice must be produced to a PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Officer if such an officer requests that it be produced.
- 4. The exemption holder shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982 or any regulations made under that Act, except where specifically exempted by this notice.
