FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, Cherie Heyes or persons acting as her agents (hereinafter referred to as the 'exemption holder') from the School of Biological Sciences, Flinders University of South Australia, G.P.O. Box 2100, Adelaide, S.A. 5001 is exempt from the provisions of Section 48G of the Fisheries Act 1982 but only insofar as to engage in the placement of settlement plates (including the removal of any organisms attached to the settlement plates), in the Barker Inlet-St Kilda Aquatic Reserve, (hereinafter referred to as the 'exempted activity'), subject to the conditions set out in Schedule 2, from the date of gazettal of this notice until 30 June 2001

SCHEDULE 1

- 1. The specimens collected by the permit holder are for scientific and research purposes only and may not be sold.
- 2. Collections undertaken in the Barker Inlet-St Kilda Aquatic Reserve must be undertaken with due consideration of other members of the public already in the area.
- 3. Before placement or collection of settlement plates pursuant to this notice, the exemption holder must advise a PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Officer on 1800 065 522.
- 4. While engaging in the exempted activity, the exemption holder must be in possession of a copy of this notice. Such notice must be produced to a PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Officer if such an officer requests that it be produced.
- 5. The exemption holder shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982 or any regulations made under that Act except where specifically exempted by this notice. Dated 19 April 2001.
