FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE note that the notice made under section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, and published in the *South Australian Government Gazette*, dated 11 May 2000, on page number 2550, being the third notice on that page, which refers to Australian Fresh Seafood Pty Ltd, is hereby revoked.

FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, Dr Peter Fairweather or persons acting as his agents (hereinafter referred to as the 'exemption holder') from the School of Ecology and Environment, Deakin University, P.O. Box 423, Warrnambool, Vic. 3280 is exempt from the provisions of section 41 of the Fisheries Act 1982 but only insofar as to engage in the activities specified in Schedule 1 (hereinafter referred to as the 'exempted activity'), subject to the conditions set out in Schedule 2 from the date of gazettal of this notice until 30 June 2004.

SCHEDULE 1

The collection of marine organisms from all South Australian coastal waters adjacent to the South East of South Australia, including intertidal 'rocky' reefs (not including aquatic reserves).

SCHEDULE 2

- 1. The organisms collected by the exemption holder are for scientific purposes only and may not be sold.
- 2. Collections undertaken from intertidal 'rocky' reef areas must be undertaken with due consideration of other members of the public already in the area.
- 3. Before collecting any organisms pursuant to this notice, the exemption holder must advise PIRSA Fisheries on 1800 065 522 with details of the name of the authorised person conducting the exempted activity, the proposed locations and the dates and times on which the collections are to be made.
- 4. While engaging in the exempted activity, the exemption holder must be in possession of a copy of this notice and must produce it to a PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Officer if such an officer requests that it be produced.
- 5. The exemption holder shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982 or any regulations made under that Act, except where specifically exempted by this notice.
