Data that is provided will be assessed as to the quality of the data matched and will be accessed by a data matching officer. All information received will be stored on a restricted access drive and deleted within four weeks of receiving.

FRUIT AND PLANT PROTECTION ACT 1992

Control of Lupin Anthracnose

PURSUANT to section 14 of the Fruit and Plant Protection Act 1992, I, Paul Holloway, Minister for Agriculture, Food and Fisheries, hereby revoke the Ministerial Notice of 10 December 1998 that established the Lupin Anthracnose Quarantine Zone on the Lower Eyre Peninsula.

Declare the portion of the State of South Australia comprising the Eyre Peninsula region situated to the south of a direct line between the Port Augusta township and the Ceduna township to be a quarantine area with respect to the disease Lupin Anthracnose (*Colletotrichum gloeosporiodes*). Prohibit the removal of any lupin seed, lupin plants or other lupin material to other parts of South Australia unless the owners or occupiers of land or premises within the quarantine area comply with the following measures:

In the case of seed, such seed complies with one of the following:

- (a) the seed has been tested and found to be negative for the presence of lupin anthracnose by a testing regime that is accepted by the Chief Inspector, and the seed is accompanied by an application to transport lupin grain which has been authorised by the Chief Inspector or his delegate; or
- (b) the seed is moved under the provisions of a compliance agreement to an approved processor for devitalisation treatment; or
- (c) the seed is moved under the provisions of a compliance agreement for other treatment and/or disposal as approved by the Chief Inspector or his delegate.

In the case of lupin plants including hay/fodder containing lupin plants, the plants or hay/fodder are either derived from a crop that has been inspected and found free of lupin anthracnose and the consignment is accompanied by a Plant Health Certificate issued by an authorised Inspector, or, as approved by the Chief Inspector or his delegate, is subject to secure transport to an approved processor for treatment including controlled feeding.

In the case of other lupin material, as approved by the Chief Inspector or his delegate, the lupin material is subject to secure transport to an approved processor for treatment including controlled feeding.

Stipulate that:

'approved processor' means a business that is approved by an Inspector to undertake a specified treatment including controlled feeding;

'compliance agreement' means a written agreement between the proponent and the Minister under the Plant Quarantine Standard South Australia which specifies the conditions that must be met by the proponent or his/her agent in relation to movement of lupin material from within the quarantine area to other parts of South Australia.

GAMING MACHINES ACT 1992, SECTION 72A (3) and (3aa): NOTICE OF CALCULATION AND PAYMENT OF MONTHLY INSTALMENTS OF GAMING TAX

Notice by the Minister for Gambling

PURSUANT to section 72A of the Gaming Machines Act 1992 (the Act):

- 1. I revoke the notice relating to the calculation of monthly instalments of gaming tax made by the Treasurer on 13 June 1996 (see *Gazette* 13 June 1996 p. 2920).
- 2. I declare that the holder of a gaming machine licence must pay to the Treasurer the monthly instalment of the prescribed gaming tax, calculated in accordance with this notice, within 7 days of the end of the month.
- 3. I declare that, for the 2002-2003 financial year, each monthly instalment of gaming tax is to be calculated on a cumulative year-to-date basis in accordance with (A), as adjusted, for the 6 months from 1 January 2003 until 30 June 2003 by subtracting or adding (as the case requires) an amount in accordance with (B):
 - (A) (i) the instalment payable for July will be the prescribed gaming tax on the NGR derived by the licensee in July (but applying a tax threshold or thresholds of ¹/₁₂ of the annual tax threshold or thresholds for the 2002-2003 financial year);
 - (ii) the instalment payable for August will be the difference between the prescribed gaming tax on the total NGR derived by the licensee for July and

- August (but applying a tax threshold or tax thresholds of $^2/_{12}$ of the annual tax threshold or thresholds for the 2002-2003 financial year) and the instalment that was payable for July;
- (iii) the instalment payable in respect of September will be the difference between the prescribed gaming tax on the total NGR derived by the licensee for July, August and September (but applying a tax threshold or tax thresholds of ³/₁₂ of the annual tax threshold or thresholds for the 2002-2003 financial year) and the total of the instalments that were payable for July and August;
- (iv) the instalment payable in respect of October will be the difference between the prescribed gaming tax on the total NGR derived by the licensee for July, August, September and October (but applying a tax threshold or tax thresholds of ⁴/₁₂ of the annual tax threshold or thresholds for the 2002-2003 financial year) and the total of the instalments that were payable for July, August and September;
- (v) and so on, for the rest of the financial year,

where:

NGR, in relation to a particular month, means the total amount of all bets made on the gaming machines on the licensed premises during that month less the total amount of all prizes won on the machines during that month;

prescribed gaming tax means the tax to be calculated in accordance with Part 1 of the table set out in paragraph (a) (i) or (ii) (as the case requires) of the definition of prescribed gaming tax in section 72 of the Act;

- (B) (i) the instalment payable for January will be the prescribed gaming tax on the NGR derived by the licensee in January (but applying an adjustment threshold or thresholds of $^{1}/_{6}$ of the adjustment threshold or thresholds for the second 6 months);
 - (ii) the instalment payable for February will be the difference between the prescribed gaming tax on the NGR derived by the licensee in January and February (but applying an adjustment threshold or thresholds of ²/₆ of the adjustment threshold or thresholds for the second 6 months) and the tax instalment that was payable for January;
 - (iii) the instalment payable for March will be the difference between the prescribed gaming tax on the NGR derived by the licensee in January, February and March (but applying an adjustment threshold or thresholds of ³/₆ of the adjustment threshold or thresholds applicable for the second 6 months) and the total of the tax instalments that were payable for January and February;
 - (iv) and so on, for the rest of the second six months,

where:

NGR, in relation to a particular month, means the total amount of all bets made on the gaming machines on the licensed premises during that month less the total amount of all prizes won on the machines during that month:

prescribed gaming tax means the tax to be calculated in accordance with Part 2 of the table set out in paragraph (a) (i) or (ii) (as the case requires) of the definition of prescribed gaming tax in section 72 of the Act;

second 6 months means 1 January 2003 until 30 June 2003.

- 4. I declare that each monthly instalment of tax in respect of the 2003-2004 financial year and each successive year is to be calculated on a cumulative year-to-date basis as follows:
 - (a) the instalment payable in respect of July will be the prescribed gaming tax on the NGR derived by the licensee in July (but applying a tax threshold or tax thresholds of $^{1}/_{12}$ of the annual tax threshold or thresholds applicable for the particular financial year);

- (b) the instalment payable in respect of August will be the difference between the prescribed gaming tax on the total NGR derived by the licensee in July and August (but applying a tax threshold or tax thresholds of ²/₁₂ of the annual tax threshold or thresholds applicable for the particular financial year) and the tax instalment that was payable in respect of July;
- (c) the instalment payable in respect of September will be the difference between the prescribed gaming tax on the total NGR derived by the licensee in July, August and September (but applying a tax threshold or tax thresholds of ³/₁₂ of the annual tax threshold or thresholds applicable for the particular financial year) and the total of the tax instalments that were payable in respect of July and August;
- (d) the instalment payable in respect of October will be the difference between the prescribed gaming tax on the total NGR derived by the licensee in July, August, September and October (but applying a tax threshold or tax thresholds of ⁴/₁₂ of the annual tax threshold or thresholds applicable for the particular financial year) and the total of the tax instalments that were payable in respect of July, August and September;
- (e) and so on, for the rest of the financial year,

where:

NGR, in relation to a particular month, means the total amount of all bets made on the gaming machines on the licensed premises during that month less the total amount of all prizes won on the machines during that month;

prescribed gaming tax, in relation to the 2003-2004 financial year and each successive year means the tax to be calculated in accordance with paragraph (b) (i) or (ii) (as the case requires) of the definition of prescribed gaming tax in section 72 of the Act.



BY-LAW MADE UNDER THE LOCAL GOVERNMENT ACT 1999

By-law No. 3—Local Government Land

FOR the management and regulation of the use of and access to local government land (other than roads under the Local Government Act 1999 and adjacent land under the Harbors and Navigation Act 1993) vested in or under the control of the council, including the prohibition and regulation of particular activities on local government land.

Definitions

- 1. In this by-law:
 - "authorised person" means a person appointed an authorised person pursuant to Section 260 of the Local Government Act 1999;
 - (2) "council" means the District Council of the Copper
 - (3) "liquor" has the same meaning as defined in the Liquor Licensing Act 1997;
 - (4) "local government land" means land owned by the council or under the council's care, control and management (except roads under the Local Government Act 1999 and adjacent land under the Harbors and Navigation Act 1993);

- (5) "open container" means a container which:
 - (a) after the contents thereof have been sealed at the time of manufacture and:
 - being a bottle, has had its cap, cork or top removed (whether or not it has since been replaced);
 - (ii) being a can, it has been opened or punctured;
 - (iii) being a cask, has had its tap placed in a position to allow it to be used;
 - (iv) being any form of container, it has been opened, broken, punctured or manipulated in such a way as to allow access to the contents thereof; or
 - (b) is a flask, glass or mug or other container used for drinking purposes;
- (6) "public place" for the purposes of paragraph 3 of this by-law means a place (including a place on private land) to which the public has access (except a road) but does not include any part of a community parcel divided by a plan of community division under the Community Titles Act 1996.

Activities requiring permission

2. No person shall without permission on any local govern-ment land:

Vehicles Generally

 being the driver of a vehicle, fail to obey the indications given by any traffic control device (as defined in the Road Traffic Act 1961) or any sign erected by or with the authority of the council, for regulating traffic or indicating the direction or route to be followed by traffic on that land;

Vehicles on Parks and Reserves

- (2) comprising parks or reserves:
 - (a) drive, park or propel a motor vehicle unless on an area constructed or set aside by the council for the parking or travelling of motor vehicles;
 - (b) ride, drive or propel a bicycle or a skateboard thereon except upon areas set aside for that purpose;
 - (c) except on a properly constructed area for the purpose, promote, organise or take part in any race, test or trial of any kind in which motor vehicles, motor cycles, motor scooters or bicycles take part;

Working on Vehicles

(3) perform the work of repairing, washing, painting, panel beating or other work of any nature on or to any vehicle, boat or trailer, except for running repairs in the case of breakdown;

Selling

(4) sell anything or display anything for sale;

Busking

(5) sing, busk or play a musical instrument for the purpose of or so as to appear to be for the purpose of entertaining others or receiving money;

Preaching

(6) preach or harangue;

Horses, Cattle, etc.

(7) ride, lead or drive any horse, cattle or sheep, except where the council has set aside a track or other area for use by or in connection with an animal of that kind;

Donations

(8) ask for or receive or indicate that he or she desires a donation of money or any other thing;

Amplification

(9) use an amplifier or other device whether mechanical or electrical for the purpose of amplifying sound;

Distribution

(10) distribute anything to any bystander, passer by or other person except for any material for the purposes of a Local, State or Federal election or to a handbill or leaflet given out or distributed during the course of and for the purpose of a referendum;

Canvassing

(11) convey any advertising, religious or other message to any bystander, passer by or other person except for any message conveyed for the purposes of a Local, State or Federal election or to a handbill or leaflet given out or distributed during the course of and for the purposes of a referendum:

Advertising

(12) display any sign for the purpose of advertising;

Fires

- (13) light or maintain any fire except:
 - (a) in a place provided by the council for that purpose;
 - (b) in a portable barbeque, as long as the barbeque is used in an area that is clear of flammable material;

Fireworks

(14) use, ignite, discharge or explode any fireworks;

Animals in Ponds

(15) comprising a pond, stream or lake, to which this subparagraph applies, allow or suffer any animal to enter or remain therein;

Attachment to Trees

(16) attach, hang or fix any rug, blanket, sheet, rope or other material to any tree, shrub, plant, tree guard, tree stake, notice board, seat, fence, post or other item or structure which is the property of the council;

Removing Soil etc.

(17) carry away or remove any soil, sand, timber, stones, other organic or inorganic materials or any part of the land;

Picking Fruit, etc.

(18) pick fruit, nuts or berries from any trees or bushes;

Digging Soil, etc.

(19) to which this subparagraph applies, dig the soil for or collect worms, grubs or insects;

Trees, plants etc.

- (20) (a) take, uproot or damage any tree, plant or flower;
 - (b) remove, take or disturb any soil, stone, wood, timber or bark:
 - (c) collect or take any dead wood or timber for the purpose of using the same to make or maintain a fire; or
 - (d) ride or drive any vehicle or animal or run, stand or walk on any flower bed or garden plot;

Fauna

- (21) (a) take, interfere with or disturb any animal or bird or the eggs or young of any animal or bird;
 - (b) disturb, interfere with or damage any burrow, nest or habitat of any animal or bird; or
 - use or have control of any device for the purpose of killing or capturing any animal or bird;

Games

- (22) (a) to which this subparagraph applies, participate in any game, recreation or amusement which involves the use of a ball, missile or other object which by the use thereof may cause injury or discomfort to any person being on or in the vicinity of that land; or
 - (b) play any organised competition sport;

Swimming

(23) swim or bathe in any pond, stream or lake to which this subparagraph applies;

Fishing

(24) fish in any pond, stream or lake to which this subparagraph applies;

No Liquor

- (25) (a) consume, carry or be in possession or charge of any liquor on any local government land to which this subparagraph applies (provided the land constitutes parks or reserves);
 - (b) excepting sealed containers, consume, carry, be in possession or charge of any liquor in an open container on any local government land to which this subparagraph applies (provided the land constitutes parks or reserves);

Weddings

(26) conduct or participate in a marriage ceremony on any park or reserve;

Closed Lands

- (27) enter or remain on any part of local government land:
 - (a) at any time during which the council has declared that it shall be closed to the public and which is indicated by a sign to that effect;
 - (b) where the land is enclosed with fences and/or walls, and gates, at any time when the gates have been closed and locked; or
 - (c) where admission charges are payable, to enter without paying those charges;

Camping

(28) camp or stay overnight thereon;

Tents

(29) erect any tent or other structure of calico, canvas, plastic or similar material;

Footway etc.

(30) comprising a park or reserve, obstruct any footway, roadway or path.

Posting of Bills etc.

3. No person shall without permission post any bills, advertisements or other papers or items on a building, or structure on local government land or other public place.

Prohibited Activities

4. No person shall on local government land:

Smoking

 smoke tobacco or any other substance in any building or part of any building to which this subparagraph applies;

Missiles

(2) throw, roll or discharge any stone, substance or missile to the danger of any person or animal therein;

Glass

 wilfully break any glass, china, ceramics or other similar brittle material;

Defacing Property

(4) deface, paint, write, cut names or make marks on any tree, rock, gate, fence, building, sign or other property of the council therein;

Use of Equipment

(5) use any item of equipment and/or facilities or other council property other than in the manner and for the purpose for which it was designed or set aside;

Annoyances

(6) annoy or unreasonably interfere with any other person's use of the land by making a noise or by creating a disturbance that has not been authorised by the council; Interference with Permitted Use

(7) interrupt or disrupt or interfere with any person's use of local government land for which permission has been granted;

Encroachment

(8) erect or place any fencing, posts or other structures or any other items or substances such as to encroach onto the land that have not been authorised by the council;

Interference with Land

(9) interfere with the land or otherwise use the land in a manner contrary to the purpose for which the land was designed to be used.

Removal of Encroachment or Interference

5. Any person who encroaches onto or interferes with local government land contrary to this by-law must at the request of an authorised person, cease the encroachment or interference and remove the source of the encroachment or interference, and reinstate the land to the same standard as the state of the land prior to the encroachment or interference.

Council may do work

- 6. If a person fails to remove an encroachment or interference on local government land in accordance with a request of an authorised person pursuant to paragraph 5 of this by-law, then the council may:
 - (a) undertake the work itself; and
 - (b) recover the cost of doing so from that person.

Directions

- 7. Any person on local government land must comply with any reasonable direction or request from an authorised person relating to:
 - (a) that person's use of the land;
 - (b) that person's conduct and behaviour on the land;
 - (c) that person's safety on the land;
 - (d) the safety and enjoyment of the land by other persons.

Removal of Animals and Persons

- 8. (1) If any animal is found on local government land in breach of a by-law:
 - (a) any person in charge of the animal shall remove it on the request of an authorised person; and
 - (b) an authorised person may remove the animal if a person fails to comply with the request, or if no person is in charge of the animal.
- (2) An authorised person may direct any person who is considered to be committing or has committed a breach of this bylaw to leave that part of the local government land. Failure to comply with that direction forthwith is a breach of this by-law.

Application

9. The restrictions in this by-law do not apply to any police officer, council employee acting in the course and within the scope of that person's normal duties, or to a contractor while performing work for the council or to the driver of an emergency vehicle (within the meaning of the Road Traffic Act 1961 or the Australian Road Rules) while driving that vehicle in relation to an emergency.

Application of Paragraphs

10. Any of paragraphs 2 (15), 2 (19), 2 (22) (a), 2 (23), 2 (24), 2 (25) (a) and (b) and 4 (1) of this by-law shall apply only in such part or parts of the area of the council as the council may by resolution direct (in accordance with Section 246 (3) (e) of the Local Government Act 1999).

The foregoing by-law was duly made and passed at a meeting of the council of the District Council of the Copper Coast held on 4 December 2002, by an absolute majority of the members for the time being constituting the council, there being at least two-thirds of the members present.
