# FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, Astrid Kodric-Brown (the 'exemption holder') or persons acting as her agent, from the Department of Biology, University of New Mexico, Albuquerque, New Mexico, U.S.A. 87131 is exempt from the provisions of section 41 of the Fisheries Act 1982 and Schedule 1 of the Fisheries (General) Regulations 2000 and section 42 of the Fisheries Act 1982 and subregulation 6 (a) of the Fisheries (General) Regulations 2000, but only insofar as to engage in the activities specified in Schedule 1 (the 'exempted activity'), using the gear specified in Schedule 2, subject to the conditions set out in Schedule 3 from the date of gazettal of this notice until 31 October 2003, unless varied or revoked earlier.

## SCHEDULE 1

The collection of goby (*Chlamydogobius gloveri*), gudgeon (*Morgurnda thermophila*), catfish (*Neosilurus glover*) perch (*Leipotherapon unicolor*) and hardyheads (*Craterocephalus gloveri* and *Craterocephalus dalhousiensis*) from the waters of Dalhouse Springs in Witjira National Park.

# SCHEDULE 2

- 1 dab net per person
- 1 minnow trap
- 1 small mesh seine net

# SCHEDULE 3

1. The specimens collected by the exemption holder are for scientific and research purposes only and may not be sold.

- 2. All native fish other than the species listed in Schedule 1 must be immediately returned to the water.
- 3. All species retained for scientific purposes must be delivered to the South Australian Museum.
- 4. Before collecting any specimens pursuant to this notice, the exemption holder must advise the PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Unit on 1800 065 522 with the name of the person who will be conducting the exempted activity, details of the proposed locations and the dates on which the collections are to be made.
- 5. The exemption holder must provide a report in writing detailing the collection of fish pursuant to this notice to the Director of Fisheries, (Attention: Roger Hill, P.O. Box 282, Port Adelaide, S.A. 5015) within 14 days of the last collection, giving the following details:
  - the date and time of collection;
  - · the description of all species collected; and
  - the number of each species collected.
- 6. While engaging in the exempted activity, the exemption holder must be in possession of a copy of this notice. Such notice must be produced to a PIRSA Fisheries Compliance Officer if such an officer requests that it be produced.
- 7. The exemption holder shall not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982 or any regulations made under that Act, except where specifically exempted by this notice.
