FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, the holder of a prawn fishery licence issued pursuant to the Scheme of Management (Prawn Fisheries) Regulations 1991 or their agent listed in Schedule 1 (the 'exemption holders') are exempt from the notices made under section 43 of the Fisheries Act 1982, prohibiting the taking of western king prawns (Melicertus latisulcatus), in that the exemption holders shall not be guilty of an offence when using prawn trawl nets in accordance with the conditions of their fishery licence for the purpose of stock assessment survey (the 'exempted activity') subject to the conditions contained in Schedule 2.

SCHEDULE 2

- 1. The exemption is valid from 11 November 2004 until 13 November 2004, unless varied or revoked.
- 2. The exemption holder may only conduct the exempted activity between 2030 hours and 0600 hours each night.
- 3. The exemption holder must comply with the instructions from the Stock Assessment Coordinator and work in the allotted trawl station.
- 4. All fish, other than prawns taken during the exempted activity for stock assessment purposes, or fish retained for other research purposes, are to be returned to the water immediately after capture.
- 5. All prawns taken during the exempted activity are to be processed in accordance with the instructions of the Stock Assessment Coordinator.
- 6. All prawns taken during the exempted activity must be removed from the vessel in accordance with the instructions of the Stock Assessment Coordinator prior to that vessel undertaking normal fishing activity.
- 7. Prawns taken pursuant to the exempted activity are not permitted to be retained by the exemption holder, agent or crew.
- $8.\,\mathrm{The}$ exemption holder must return to the designated port of landing by 0900 hours by the last day of the survey.
- 9. The exemption holder must not contravene or fail to comply with Fisheries Act 1982, or any other regulations made under that Act except where specifically exempted by this notice.
