#### FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, Tony Lee (the 'exemption holder'), P.O. Box 242, Mount Gambier, S.A. 5291, is exempt from section 34 of the Fisheries Act 1982, but only insofar as the exemption holder may take turbo (*Turbo undulatis*) for the purpose of trade or business from South Australian coastal waters (the 'exempted activity') subject to the conditions in Schedule 1 from 22 July 2005 until 30 June 2006, unless revoked or varied earlier.

#### SCHEDULE 1

1. The exemption holder may only take turbo (*Turbo undulatis*) by diving and collection by hand.

2. The exemption holder may take no more than 1 000 kg of turbo (*Turbo undulatis*) in any one calendar month.

3. The exemption holder must provide the Director of Fisheries with separate statistical catch and effort information, in the form of a daily log as provided by the Director. The exemption holder must fill out the log every day and send a completed monthly log to the Director no later than the 15th day of the following month to the address specified.

4. The exemption holder must notify PIRSA Fisheries prior to departing on a fishing trip by calling 1800 065 522 and provide the following information:

- the name of the licence holder or registered master making the call;
- the time and date the exempted activity will commence;
- the estimated time and place of landing.

5. If the exemption holder is not able to land turbo at the estimated time (or within 30 minutes thereof) and place notified in accordance with condition 4 above, they must notify PIRSA Fisheries by calling 1800 065 522 before the estimated time provided in accordance with condition 4 and provide a new time and place of landing.

6. Turbo must not be landed at a time that is earlier then the estimated time of landing provided to PIRSA Fisheries, in accordance with conditions 4 or 5.

7. Within half an hour of returning to the place of landing the exemption holder must weigh the turbo catch and record the weight on the daily log.

8. The exemption holder must allow a departmental officer to accompany the exemption holder at any time during fishing operations.

9. While engaged in the exempted activity the exemption holder must carry or have about or near his person a copy of this notice. Such notice must be produced to a PIRSA Fisheries Officer upon request.

10. The exemption holder must not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982, or any regulations made under that Act, except where specifically exempted by this notice.

#### FISHERIES ACT 1982: SECTION 59

TAKE notice that pursuant to section 59 of the Fisheries Act 1982, David Corston (the 'exemption holder), P.O. Box 2141, Port Lincoln, S.A. 5607, is exempt from section 34 of the Fisheries Act 1982, but only insofar as the exemption holder may take turbo (*Turbo undulatis*) for the purpose of trade or business from South Australian coastal waters (the 'exempted activity') subject to the conditions in Schedule 1 from 22 July 2005 until 30 June 2006, unless revoked or varied earlier.

#### SCHEDULE 1

1. The exemption holder may only take turbo (*Turbo undulatis*) by diving and collection by hand.

2. The exemption holder may take no more than 200 kg of turbo (*Turbo undulatis*) in any one calendar week.

3. The exemption holder must provide the Director of Fisheries with separate statistical catch and effort information, in the form of a daily log as provided by the Director. The exemption holder must fill out the log every day and send a completed monthly log to the Director no later than the 15th day of the following month to the address specified.

4. The exemption holder must notify PIRSA Fisheries prior to departing on a fishing trip by calling 1800 065 522 and provide the following information:

- the name of the licence holder or registered master making the call;
- the time and date the exempted activity will commence;
- the estimated time and place of landing.

5. If the exemption holder is not able to land turbo at the estimated time and place notified in accordance with condition 4 above, they must notify PIRSA Fisheries by calling 1800 065 522 before the estimated time provided in accordance with condition 4 and provide a new time and place of landing.

6. The exemption holder must allow a departmental officer to accompany the exemption holder at any time during fishing operations.

7. While engaged in the exempted activity the exemption holder must carry or have about or near his person a copy of this notice. Such notice must be produced to a PIRSA Fisheries Officer upon request.

8. The exemption holder must not contravene or fail to comply with the Fisheries Act 1982, or any regulations made under that Act, except where specifically exempted by this notice.
