ADMINISTRATIVE ARRANGEMENTS ACT 1994

Delegation of Function or Power

PURSUANT to section 9 (1) of the Administrative Arrangements Act 1994, I, Jay Weatherill, Minister for Environment and Conservation, delegate my functions and powers under section 146 (5) of the Natural Resources Management Act 2004 to the Minister for the River Murray, but only insofar as the exercise of those functions and powers relate to the River Murray Prescribed Watercourse

TRADE STANDARDS ACT 1979

Declaration of Dangerous Goods

I, GAIL GAGO, Minister for Consumer Affairs, pursuant to section 25 (1) (a) of the Trade Standards Act 1979, declare all goods of the class specified in the Schedule below to be dangerous goods. Further, pursuant to sections 25 (2) (a) and 25 (2) (b) of the Trade Standards Act 1979, I am satisfied that this declaration is necessary in order to avert risk of injury or impairment of health, and that it is not appropriate in the circumstances to deal with the matter by the prescription of safety standards.

In making this declaration, I have had regard to the fact that, pursuant to section 24 (1) of the Trade Standards Act 1979, it is a criminal offence for a person to, in the course of a trade or business, manufacture or supply dangerous goods. This notice will remain in effect until varied or revoked.

SCHEDULE

'Sky Lanterns' which are constructed from paper or fabric on a frame which is open at one end and relies on an open flame as the heat source to heat the air inside the lantern and is intended to lift freely in the atmosphere.
