ESSENTIAL SERVICES ACT 1981 SECTION 4:
REVOCATION OF DIRECTION IN RELATION TO OPERATION OF THE NATIONAL ELECTRICITY MARKET (NEM) IN THE SOUTH AUSTRALIAN NEM REGION

REVOCATION OF MINISTERIAL DIRECTION

Preamble

- 1. A period of emergency was proclaimed under the Essential Services Act 1981.
- 2. The period of emergency applies in respect of the following essential services ('proclaimed essential services'):
 - The production, distribution or supply of electricity.
- 3. Pursuant to Section 4 of the Essential Services Act 1981, a Ministerial Direction was issued by me as Attorney-General for the State of South Australia and dated 29 September 2016, as follows:

"Pursuant to Clause 3.14.3 (2) of the National Electricity Rules (NER), the Australian Energy Market Operator is directed to suspend the market in the South Australian National Electricity Market region until this direction is revoked."

4. I am of the opinion that it is in the public interest to now revoke this Ministerial Direction.

Notice of Revocation

PURSUANT to Section 4 of the Essential Services Act 1981, being of opinion that it is in the public interest to do so:

1. The Ministerial Direction issued by me, Attorney-General for the State of South Australia and dated 29 September 2016, providing for the suspension of the market in the South Australian National Electricity Market Region, is revoked in full.
