NOTIFICATION OF ALTERATION TO THE TASMANIAN GIANT CRAB MANAGEMENT PLAN

I, ROB GOTT, Director (Marine Resources) in the Department of Primary Industries, Parks, Water and Environment, pursuant to the delegated authority under Section 20(2) of the *Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995* and in accordance with section 57 of that Act, hereby notify that:

- (a) As a result of a review the Minister has accepted a recommendation to alter the management plan for the giant crab fishery- *Fisheries (Giant Crab) Rules 2006*.
- (b) The *Fisheries (Giant Crab) Amendment Rules 2010*, amend the *Fisheries (Giant Crab) Rules 2006* by:
 - updating management arrangements for the commercial giant crab fishery, including provisions to allow size limits to be set by public notice and varying the requirements to use extra traps in deep water; and
 - including updated infringement notice offences and penalties that are being "transferred" from the *Fisheries (Infringement Notices) Regulations 2001*.
- (c) The alterations take effect on the date that the notification of making the rules is published in the *Tasmanian Government Gazette*.

NOTIFICATION OF ALTERATION TO THE TASMANIAN ROCK LOBSTER MANAGEMENT PLAN

I, ROB GOTT, Director (Marine Resources) in the Department of Primary Industries, Parks, Water and Environment, pursuant to the delegated authority under Section 20(2) of the *Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995* and in accordance with section 57 of that Act, hereby notify that:

- (a) As a result of a review the Minister has accepted a recommendation to alter the management plan for the rock lobster fishery - *Fisheries (Rock Lobster) Rules 2006*.
- (b) The *Fisheries (Rock Lobster) Amendment Rules 2010*, amend the *Fisheries (Rock Lobster) Rules 2006* by:
 - updating management arrangements for the commercial rock lobster fishery, including increasing the number of units that can be held on a fishing licence (rock lobster) and providing a by-catch provision for small inshore crab species; and
 - including updated infringement notice offences and penalties that are being "transferred" from the *Fisheries (Infringement Notices) Regulations 2001*.
- (c) The alterations take effect on the date that the notification of making the rules is published in the *Tasmanian Government Gazette*.

GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT OF THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

(1) *Fisheries (Giant Crab) Amendment Rules 2010*

These rules amend the *Fisheries (Giant Crab) Rules 2006* by –

- (a) updating management arrangements for the commercial giant crab fishery; and
- (b) introducing a new minimum size limit for the taking of male giant crab and allowing the size limits for giant crab to be set by public notice; and
- (c) including infringement notice offences and penalties that are being “transferred” from the *Fisheries (Infringement Notices) Regulations 2001*; and
- (d) extending the duration of the rules from 5 to 7 years.

(2) *Fisheries (Rock Lobster) Amendment Rules 2010*

These rules amend the *Fisheries (Rock Lobster) Rules 2006* by –

- (a) updating management arrangements for the commercial rock lobster fishery; and
- (b) including infringement notice offences and penalties that are being “transferred” from the *Fisheries (Infringement Notices) Regulations 2001*.

(3) *Fisheries (Scallop) Rules 2010*

These rules provide for –

- (a) the management of the scallop fishery; and
- (b) licences for that fishery; and
- (c) reporting and other requirements relating to that fishery.
