Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995 Fisheries (Abalone) Rules 2009, Rule 9

Public Notice - Dates of Closing of the Recreational Abalone Fishery for State Waters from The Southern Point of Diamond Island to Cape Lodi in the South

I, Wes Ford, General Manager, Water and Marine Resources, pursuant to Rule 9 of the *Fisheries (Abalone) Rules 2009*, and delegated authority under Section 20(1) of the *Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995*, hereby determine that the dates of the closed season for the taking of abalone (*Genus Haliotis*) for recreational purposes from all state waters within the area south of a line of latitude commencing from the southern point of Diamond Island to a line of latitude commencing at Cape Lodi including the area known as Waub's Bay to be:–

- from 19 January 2011 to April 2011, inclusive;

ORDER RELATING TO DISEASED AREA (RESTRICTIONS ON RECREATIONAL ABALONE FISHING FROM THE SOUTHERN POINT OF DIAMOND ISLAND TO CAPE LODI)

I, Wes Ford as General Manager, Water and Marine Resources pursuant to Section 271 of the Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995 and under delegated authority under Section 20(1) of the Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995 declare that all state waters within the area south of a line of latitude commencing from the southern point of Diamond Island to a line of latitude commencing at Cape Lodi including the area known as Waub's Bay to be diseased having Abalone Viral Ganglioneuritis present, and therefore prohibit the take of abalone (*Genus Haliotis*) from those waters for the period extending from 19 January 2011 to 1 April 2011 (inclusive).
