PUBLIC NOTICE - DATES OF OPENING AND CLOSING OF THE ROCK LOBSTER FISHERY

Rule 11 of The Fisheries (Rock Lobster) Rules 2011

I, ROB GOTT, Director (Marine Resources), pursuant to my delegated power under section 20 (1) of the *Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995*, in accordance with Rule 11 (2) of the *Fisheries (Rock Lobster) Rules 2011*, hereby determine that:

(1) the part of the commercial rock lobster fishery comprising of activities by way of setting rock lobster pots and taking male and female rock lobster for commercial purposes in eastern waters will be closed from 13 November 2012

Where:

"eastern waters" is defined to mean the area of State waters adjacent to the east coast of Tasmania bounded in the north on the east coast by the line of latitude at 41° 1' 0" South and bounded in the south on the east coast by an the line of latitude at 42° 49' 00" South.

Words and expressions used in this public notice have the same meaning as in the *Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995* and the *Fisheries (Rock Lobster) Rules 2011.*
