FISHERIES (RESEARCH AREA) ORDER (NO. 1) 2012

I MAKE THE FOLLOWING ORDER UNDER SECTION 143 OF THE *Living Marine Resources Management Act 1995*.

Short title

1. This order may be cited as the *Fisheries (Research Area) Order (No. 1) 2012*.

Commencement

2. This order takes effect on the day on which it is published in the *Gazette* and remains in force until 31 October 2013.

Interpretation

3. In this order -

“**Wineglass Bay Research Area**” means the area specified in clause 4.

Research Area

4. The following part of State waters is declared to be a research area: the part of State waters on the east coast of Tasmania adjacent to Wineglass Bay that is within an imaginary line commencing at the intersection of the high-water mark at Sleepy Bay with the line of longitude 148° 19' 13.52" East then following the line of the high-water mark in an approximately southerly direction to the line of latitude 42° 11' 36.04" South then running due east to the line of longitude 148° 22' 52.72" East then running in a straight line to the point of commencement at Sleepy Bay.

Restrictions on taking fish in the research area

5. The following specified restrictions are declared to apply in the Wineglass Bay Research Area: the holder of a fishing licence (abalone dive) or of a fishing licence (commercial dive) must not, when operating under either of those licences, in the Wineglass Bay Research Area—

take any fish by diving or swimming beneath the surface of the water.

Explanatory Note

This order is for the purpose of research into the control of the long-spined sea urchin (*Centrostephanus rodgersii*) and imposes restrictions on fishing in the research area.

2. The changes:
 - (a) are made by Order published in the *Gazette* on 31 October 2012 in Gazette number 21281;
 - (b) provide that the Office of Aboriginal Affairs may no longer allot unique identifying codes in respect of that fishery; and
 - (c) provide that certain requirements relating to the identification of rock lobster pots and rock lobster rings set or used by non-commercial fishers do not apply to Aborigines engaging in Aboriginal activities if certain alternative requirements are met; and
 - (d) prescribe those alternative requirements.

(Explanatory note)

This order changes the management plan for the rock lobster fishery by removing the capacity for the Office of Aboriginal Affairs to issue unique identifying codes to Aborigines to undertake cultural activities. Provides that the Secretary may issue UICs or may approve other means. Provides the capacity to implement alternate marking of fishing apparatus in consultation with Aboriginal community organisations.
