First schedule

ALL THAT parcel of land situate in the City of Launceston in Tasmania containing 2.005 hectares (area) or thereabouts delineated as Lot 1 on registered Plan No. 143190 being the land comprised in the Register Volume 143190 Folio 1 registered in the name of Cuthbertson Bros Pty Ltd.

Second schedule

Electricity easement and restriction as to user of land means:

FIRSTLY the full and free right and liberty for Transend Networks Pty Ltd and its successors and its and their servants, agents, invitees and contractors (“Transend”) at all times:

- (a) TO clear the lands marked “Electricity Infrastructure Easement” on Plan of Survey 163971 in the office of the Recorder of Titles (described as “the servient land”) and to lay, erect, construct, inspect, install, maintain, repair, modify, add to, replace, remove and operate in, upon, through, over, along and under the servient land the following designed principally or wholly for installation and installed below the surface of the servient land:
 - (i) cable bays, wires, cables, apparatus, telecommunications equipment, appliances, and all other ancillary and associated equipment (described collectively as “electricity infrastructure”) for, or principally for, the transmission of electrical energy and for any incidental purposes.

- (b) TO cause or permit electrical energy (including electromagnetic energy in all its forms), telecommunications and data to flow or be transmitted or distributed through the electricity infrastructure.
- (c) TO cut away remove and keep clear of the electricity infrastructure all trees and other obstructions or erections of any nature whatsoever which may at any time:
 - (i) overhang, encroach upon or be in or on the servient land; or
 - (ii) which may in the opinion of Transend endanger or interfere with the proper operation of the electricity infrastructure.
- (d) TO enter the servient land for all or any of the above purposes and to cross the remainder of the land with any and all necessary plant, equipment, machinery and vehicles for the purpose of access and egress to and from the servient land, and where reasonably practicable, in consultation with the registered proprietor/s (except when urgent or emergency repair work is needed).

SECONDLY the benefit of a covenant for Transend and with the registered proprietor/s for themselves and their successors not to:

- (i) erect any buildings; or
- (ii) place any structures or objects

within the servient land without the prior written consent of Transend. Transend may rescind its consent if in the opinion of Transend there are safety, access or operational concerns.

ELECTRICITY SUPPLY INDUSTRY ACT 1995

ORDER

I, BRYAN ALEXANDER GREEN, Minister administering the *Electricity Supply Industry Act 1995*, pursuant to Section 121 B and Section 121 C, having taken into account the budget prepared under section 121 0, hereby make the following order:

- (1) (a) the electricity entity that is liable to pay an annual charge for the operation and administration of the electrical safety inspection service administered by the responsible Department in relation to the *Electricity Industry Safety and Administration Act 1997* and the *Occupational Licensing Act 2005* is Aurora Energy Pty. Ltd. (ACN 082464 622); and
- (b) the amount of the charge for the six month period from 1 July 2012 until 31 December 2012 is \$1,965,301.
- (2) (a) The charge, payable to the Secretary of the Department of Justice, is to be paid into the Electrical Safety Inspection Service Fund administered by the Department of Justice; and
- (b) the charge is to be paid in equal monthly instalments on or before the second last working day in each month of 2012 until 31 December 2012 by electronic funds transfer to BSB 037 001 Account No. 267793 in the name of Department of Justice Operating Account at Westpac Banking Corporation, 28 Elizabeth Street, Hobart, Tasmania.

These regulations amend the *Taxation Administration Regulations 2010* by prescribing an administrative fee for certain documents lodged by certain agents under the *Taxation Administration Act 1997*.

Airport Fees



Hobart International Airport Pty Ltd Arrival and Departure Fees

Pursuant to section 6 of the *Aerodrome Fees Act 2002*, Hobart International Airport Pty Ltd gives notice that arrival and departure fees for domestic Regular Passenger Transport (“RPT”) aircraft at Hobart International Airport, payable by the holder of an aircraft’s certificate of registration, are fixed as follows with effect from 1 July 2012 and until further notice:

RPT ² aircraft – arrival PSC ³	Per Passenger	\$11.64 ⁴
RPT ² aircraft – arrival OSC ⁵	Per Passenger	\$1.39 ⁶
RPT ² aircraft – departure PSC ³	Per Passenger	\$11.64 ⁴
RPT ² aircraft – departure OSC ⁵	Per Passenger	\$1.39 ⁶
General Aviation - arrival	Per MTOW ⁷	\$16.50 ⁴ per 1,000kg (subject to a minimum fee of \$40.00)
Freight - arrival	Per MTOW ⁷	\$16.50 ⁴ per 1,000kg (subject to a minimum fee of \$40.00)
Rotor wing - arrival	Per MTOW ⁷	\$8.25 ⁴ per 1,000kg (subject to a minimum fee of \$30.00)
Parking – general aviation, freight and rotor wing aircraft	Per MTOW ⁷ for each day or part of a day ⁸	\$3.25 ⁴ per 1,000kg

Notes:

1. The fees specified in this notice do not include any amount for GST. The holder of an aircraft’s certificate of registration must also pay to the Hobart International Airport Pty Ltd an additional amount equal to the GST applicable at the time.
2. RPT means Regular Passenger Transport.
3. PSC means Passenger Services Charge.
4. These charges applicable as at 1 July 2012 and will increase by CPI on 1 July each year, unless amended through the publishing of alternative prices.
5. OSC means Outgoings & Security Charge.
6. This charge will vary from time to time based on the volume of passengers experienced at the airport.
7. MTOW means Maximum Take-off Weight of an aircraft as listed in the CASA Aircraft Regulation Data Base, with the fee applying per 1,000 kg of that weight pro-rata and subject to the minimum arrival fees set out above.
8. Parking fees are not payable in relation to a general aviation, freight or rotor wing aircraft lighter than 6.15 tonnes until the aircraft has been parked at the airport for 12 hours at which time a fee of \$20.00 will apply in relation to that day. Thereafter the daily rate set out above will apply.
