GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT OF THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

(1) Health (Fees) Amendment Regulations 2012

These regulations amend the Health (Fees) Regulations 2007 by -

- (a) increasing certain fees payable by or on behalf of non-nursing-home-type patients for hospital services provided to those persons in public hospitals; and
- (b) amending the fees payable by or on behalf of non-nursing-home-type patients for pharmaceutical items supplied to those persons in public hospitals.

(2) Proclamation under section 2 of the National Energy Retail Law (Tasmania) Act 2012

This proclamation fixes 1 July 2012 as the day on which the provisions of the National Energy Retail Law (Tasmania) Act 2012 commence.

(3) Proclamation under section 2 of the National Energy Retail Law (Tasmania) (Consequential Amendments)

Act 2012

This proclamation fixes 1 July 2012 as the day on which the provisions of the *National Energy Retail Law (Tasmania)* (Consequential Amendments) Act 2012, other than section 14, commence.

(4) National Energy Retail Law (Tasmania) Regulations 2012

These regulations prescribe certain matters for the purposes of the National Energy Retail Law (Tasmania) Act 2012.

(5) Electricity Supply Industry Amendment Regulations 2012

These regulations amend the *Electricity Supply Industry Regulations 2008* consequential to amendments made by the *National Energy Retail Law (Tasmania) (Consequential Amendments) Act 2012* and so as to specify how quickly electricity providers are to enable electricity to flow, on request, to premises.

(6) Electricity Supply Industry (Price Control and Related Matters) Regulations 2012

These regulations, made under the Electricity Supply Industry Act 1995 –

- (a) enable the making of price determinations, investigations in relation to the making of such determinations, and the charging of certain fees in relation to such determinations and investigations; and
- (b) establish, in certain circumstances, certain contractual relationships between electricity entities; and
- (c) rescind the *Electricity Supply Industry (Price Control) Regulations 2003* and regulations amending those regulations; and
- (d) continue in force, with certain amendments, certain declarations and determinations in force under the *Electricity Supply Industry (Price Control) Regulations 2003*.
 - (7) Proclamation under section 2 of the Poisons Amendment Act 2012

This proclamation fixes 1 July 2012 as the day on which the Poisons Amendment Act 2012 commences.

(8) Poisons (Adoption of Uniform Standard) Order 2012

This order –

- (a) adopts Part 4 and Appendix C of the Uniform Standard as the Poisons List for the purposes of the *Poisons Act* 1971; and
- (b) amends the Uniform Standard in its application to Tasmania by
 - (i) adding the items listed in Appendix C of the Uniform Standard to Part 2 of Schedule 7 to the Poisons List; and
 - (ii) adding Indian Hemp seed to the list of substances in Schedule 8 to the Poisons List.
