GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT OF THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

(1) Magistrates Court (Civil Division) (Minor Civil Claims) Regulations 2013

These regulations prescribe certain proceedings to be minor civil claims for the purpose of the definition of *minor civil claim* in the *Magistrates Court (Civil Division) Act 1992*.

(2) Public Interest Disclosures Regulations 2013

These regulations -

- (a) prescribe the procedures for making disclosures under Part 2 of the Public Interest Disclosures Act 2002; and
- (b) prescribe certain office holders as persons to whom the Ombudsman may refer a disclosed matter under that Act for investigation; and
- (c) are made consequentially on the repeal of the *Public Interest Disclosures Regulations 2003* under section 11 of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1992.*
