GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT OF THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

(1) *Criminal Investigation (Extra-Territorial Offences) Regulations 2013*

These regulations –

- (a) prescribe forms for the purposes of the *Criminal Investigation (Extra-Territorial Offences) Act 1987*; and
- (b) are made consequentially on the repeal of the *Criminal Investigation (Extra-Territorial Offences) Regulations 2003* under section 11 of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1992*.

(2) *Justices Regulations 2013*

These regulations –

- (a) prescribe certain fees payable under the *Justices Act 1959*; and
- (b) are made consequentially on the repeal of the *Justices Regulations 2003* under section 11 of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1992*.

(3) *Justices (Restraint Orders) Rules 2013*

These rules –

- (a) prescribe the procedures to be followed in relation to the making, serving, filing and hearing of applications in respect of restraint orders under the *Justices Act 1959*; and
- (b) are made consequentially on the repeal of the *Justices (Restraint Orders) Rules 2003* under section 11 of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1992*.

(4) *Prisoners (Interstate Transfer) Regulations 2013*

These regulations –

- (a) provide for various matters relating to the transfer interstate of prisoners under the *Prisoners (Interstate Transfer) Act 1982*; and
- (b) are made consequentially on the repeal of the *Prisoners (Interstate Transfer) Regulations 2003* under section 11 of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1992*.

(5) *Relationships Regulations 2013*

These regulations –

- (a) provide for an order for periodic maintenance made by the Supreme Court under section 47 of the *Relationships Act 2003* to be recorded as a judgment of the Magistrates Court; and
- (b) prescribe the fees payable under that Act; and
- (c) are made consequentially on the repeal of the *Relationships Regulations 2003* under section 11 of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1992*.

(6) *Travel Agents Regulations 2013*

These regulations –

- (a) make provision for the following matters under the *Travel Agents Act 1987*:
 - (i) certain licensing, qualifications, particulars, and administrative requirements;
 - (ii) the compensation scheme established for the purposes of the Act;
 - (iii) certain fees payable under the Act; and
- (b) are made consequentially on the repeal of the *Travel Agents Regulations 2003* under section 11 of the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1992*.

(7) Proclamation under section 2 of the *Children, Young Persons and Their Families Amendment Act 2013*

This proclamation fixes 18 December 2013 as the day on which sections 41 and 42 of the *Children, Young Persons and their Families Amendment Act 2013* commence.

(8) Proclamation under section 25(21) of the *Tasmanian Forests Agreement Act 2013*

This proclamation, under the *Tasmanian Forests Agreement Act 2013* –

- (a) removes certain areas, that are contained in the proposed reserves specified in Schedule 1 to this proclamation, from the Register of Multiple Use Forest Land; and
- (b) revokes the dedication as State forest of certain areas that are contained in the proposed reserves specified in Schedule 1 to this proclamation; and
- (c) revokes any public reserves contained in the proposed reserves specified in Schedule 1 to this proclamation; and
- (d) declares certain areas of Crown land to be reserved land in the classes of national park, regional reserve or conservation area; and
- (e) declares that the new reserves are also being declared for the additional purpose of removing carbon dioxide from the atmosphere by a range of means.
