EXEMPTION/S GRANTED

ANIMAL WELFARE (PIGS) AMENDMENT
REGULATIONS 2013

INVITATION FOR PUBLIC COMMENT

THE *Animal Welfare (Pigs) Regulations 2013* (the 'Principal Regulations') set out the agreed minimum standards for the care and management of pigs under the *Animal Welfare Act 1993*.

The *Animal Welfare (Pigs) Amendment Regulations 2013* will amend the Principal Regulations to implement new restrictions on the use of stalls to house female pigs.

A Regulatory Impact Statement (RIS) regarding the *Animal Welfare (Pigs) Amendment Regulations 2013* has been prepared by the Department of Primary Industries, Parks, Water and Environment to examine the impact of the proposed regulations on pork producers and potential entrants to that industry.
