### EXEMPTION NOTICE

T EXEM 2013-01

THIS Exemption is granted by Workplace Standards Tasmania in accordance with Section 64 of the *Dangerous Goods (Road and Rail Transport) Act 2010*

**Purpose:** To enable Tasmanian Ports Corporation to maintain fuel stocks via the transport of 25,500 litre ISO-containers of petrol (UN 1203) from the Port of Grassy on King Island to the King Island bulk fuel depot located adjacent to the Port (approximately 600 metres).

**Granted to:** Tasmanian Ports Corporation, Grassy Harbour Road, King Island, Tasmania.

**Regulations:** Exemption from the restraint provisions for portable tanks as required by the Dangerous Goods (Road and Rail Transport) Regulations 2010 Part 8 and contrary to the instruction contained within clause 8.2.2.3 of the Australian Dangerous Goods Code 7th Edition (ADG7).

**Conditions:**

1. Vehicle speed not to exceed 30km/h whilst transporting loaded Iso container.
2. All twist locks to be engaged during transit.
3. Extreme care to be taken when negotiating turns.
4. Driver of the combination to hold the relevant class of licence for the transportation of dangerous goods.
5. Prime mover and trailer to undergo current inspection programme for transporting dangerous goods.
6. Exemption applicable only for vehicle identified as VT5755.
7. All other provisions of the ADG Code 7 and the *Dangerous Goods (Road and Rail Transport) Regulations 2010* shall apply.
8. The driver must carry a copy of this exemption when transporting petrol (UN 1203).

**Application:** This exemption applies only in the state of Tasmania.

**Starting Date:** 1 August 2013

**Finish Date:** The Exemption shall be valid until ADG7 ceases to have legal effect in Tasmania, the Exemption can also be revoked, withdrawn or amended.

### EXEMPTION NOTICE

T EXEM 2013-02

THIS Exemption is granted in accordance with Section 64 of the *Dangerous Goods (Road and Rail Transport) Act 2010*

**Purpose:** To exempt the class of persons described in this Exemption Notice from the licensing requirements as stipulated under legislation relating to the transport of certain quantities of explosives.

**Granted to:** Persons who, under the authority of a current Security-sensitive Dangerous Substance (SSDS) Permit issued under the Security-sensitive Dangerous Substances Act 2005, are permitted to transport the dangerous goods specified in this Exemption Notice (the class of persons).

**Regulations:** This Exemption Notice exempts the above class of persons from the requirement of regulation 199(c) of the Dangerous Goods (Road and Rail Transport) Regulations 2010 to hold a dangerous goods driver licence authorising the person to drive a road vehicle carrying the dangerous goods specified below.

**Dangerous Goods:** Dangerous goods of UN Class 1 (explosives) in quantities with a risk category of 2 under Chapter 2 of the Australian Explosives Code, Edition 3 (the AE Code).

**Application:** This Exemption Notice applies within the geographical boundaries of the state of Tasmania.

**Time Period:** This exemption in this Notice commences on 1 September 2013.

Unless revoked, suspended or amended earlier, this Exemption shall be valid until the Dangerous Goods (Road and Rail Transport) Act ceases to have legal effect in Tasmania.

**Conditions:** The Exemption outlined in this Notice is subject to the conditions below and applies only:

1. To persons who have authority under an SSDS Permit to transport explosives.
2. Where the owner of the road vehicle and/or prime contractor has ensured that the driver has been adequately instructed in the hazardous properties of explosives transported on a road vehicle.
3. Where drivers conveying explosives do so in accordance with all relevant obligations under the of the *Dangerous Goods (Road and Rail Transport) Act 2010* and safety requirements of the AE Code.

**Important note:**

This exemption from licensing of drivers as outlined in this Notice does not extend to explosives transported by road in amounts that would qualify as 'Risk Category 3' loads as prescribed in the AE Code.
