## GENERAL PURPORT OR EFFECT of THE ABOVEMENTIONED STATUTORY RULES

(1) Fisheries (Rock Lobster) Amendment Rules 2014

These rules amend the Fisheries (Rock Lobster) Rules 2011 by -

- (a) providing for catch-cap areas determined under the *Living Marine Resources Management Act* 1995; and
- (b) updating the Schedule of infringement notice offences and penalties; and
- (c) making various other miscellaneous amendments.

(2) Mineral Resources (Deferral of Royalty) Order 2014

This order prescribes, for the purposes of section 102AA of the *Mineral Resources Development Act 1995*, the criteria that must be satisfied before the payment of an amount of royalty can be deferred under that section.

# (3) Vehicle and Traffic (Vehicle Operations) Amendment Notice 2014

This notice amends the Vehicle and Traffic (Vehicle Operations) Notice 2013 by -

- (a) amending the provisions that relate to higher mass limits for vehicles with road-friendly suspension; and
- (b) updating and revising certain definitions; and
- (c) making other minor and consequential amendments.
